# **Conjugate Burn**

### **Burn in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>burn</b>	We <b>burn</b>
You <b>burn</b>	You <b>burn</b>
He/She/It <b>burns</b>	They <b>burn</b>

## **Burn in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am burning	We <b>are burning</b>
You <b>are burning</b>	You <b>are burning</b>
He/She/It <b>is burning</b>	They <b>are burning</b>

#### **Burn in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have burned or burnt (mostly uk)	We have burned or burnt (mostly uk)
You have burned or burnt (mostly uk)	You have burned or burnt (mostly uk)
He/She/It has burned or burnt (mostly uk)	They have burned or burnt (mostly uk)

### **Burn in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been burning	We have been burning
You <b>have been burning</b>	You have been burning
He/She/It has been burning	They have been burning

## **Burn in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I burned or burnt (mostly uk)	We <b>burned or burnt (mostly uk)</b>
You <b>burned or burnt (mostly uk)</b>	You <b>burned or burnt (mostly uk)</b>
He/She/It burned or burnt (mostly uk)	They burned or burnt (mostly uk)

#### **Burn in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was burning	We <b>were burning</b>
You <b>were burning</b>	You were burning
He/She/It was burning	They were burning

### **Burn in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had burned or burnt (mostly uk)	We had burned or burnt (mostly uk)
You had burned or burnt (mostly uk)	You had burned or burnt (mostly uk)
He/She/It had burned or burnt (mostly uk)	) They had burned or burnt (mostly uk)

## **Burn in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been burning	We had been burning
You <b>had been burning</b>	You had been burning
He/She/It had been burning	They had been burning

## **Burn in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will burn</b>	We <b>will burn</b>
You <b>will burn</b>	You <b>will burn</b>
He/She/It will burn	They <b>will burn</b>

## **Burn in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be burning	We will be burning
You <b>will be burning</b>	You <b>will be burning</b>
He/She/It will be burning	They will be burning

### **Burn in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have burned or burnt (mostly uk)	We <b>will have burned or burnt (mostly uk)</b>
You will have burned or burnt (mostly uk)	You <b>will have burned or burnt (mostly</b> <b>uk)</b>
He/She/It <b>will have burned or burnt</b> (mostly uk)	They will have burned or burnt (mostly uk)

## **Burn in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been burning	We <b>will have been burning</b>
You <b>will have been burning</b>	You <b>will have been burning</b>
He/She/It will have been burning	They will have been burning
