- A noise made by air released from the stomach through the mouth; a belch.






Synonyms of "Burp" as a noun (4 Words)

An act of belching. belch He gave a loud **belch**.

The forceful expulsion of something from inside. belching The **belching** of smoke from factory chimneys.

A reflex that expels gas noisily from the stomach through the mouth. burping







Burp as a Verb

Definitions of "Burp" as a verb

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "burp" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- Noisily release air from the stomach through the mouth; belch.
- Make (a baby) belch after feeding, typically by patting its back.
- Expel gas from the stomach.

Synonyms of "Burp" as a verb (4 Words)

belch Expel gas from the stomach.

Flames **belch** from the wreckage.

bring up wind Cause to happen or to occur as a consequence.

bubble Of a liquid form rising bubbles of gas or air.

A pot of coffee **bubble**d away on the stove.

eruct Emit stomach gas noisily through the mouth; belch.
