**man of affairs** A manservant who acts as a personal attendant to his employer.

- backer** A person that bets on a horse.  
*He was the principal **backer** of the company.*
- billionaire** A very rich person whose material wealth is valued at more than a billion dollars.
- bursar** A student who holds a bursary.
- business** Business concerns collectively.  
*He s not in my line of **business**.*
- capitalist** Of or relating to capitalism or capitalists.  
***Capitalistic** methods and incentives.*
- demagogue** Rhetorically exploit (an issue) for political purposes in a way calculated to appeal to the desires and prejudices of ordinary people.  
*A gifted **demagogue** with particular skill in manipulating the press.*
- diplomat** A person who deals tactfully with others.

<b>diplomatist</b>	An official engaged in international negotiations. A promoter in the entertainment industry.
<b>entrepreneur</b>	<i>The music <b>entrepreneur</b> pulled back from financing a screenplay Hopper had written.</i>
<b>fetching</b>	Attractive. <i>A <b>fetching</b> new hairstyle.</i>
<b>financial</b>	Involving financial matters. <i>He needs to pay serious attention to his <b>financials</b> particularly cash flow.</i>
<b>financier</b>	Conduct financial operations, often in an unethical manner.
<b>flourishing</b>	Very lively and profitable. <i><b>Flourishing</b> businesses.</i>
<b>freemason</b>	A member of a widespread secret fraternal order pledged to mutual assistance and brotherly love.
<b>immensely</b>	To a great extent; extremely. <i>The president was <b>immensely</b> popular.</i>
<b>immensity</b>	Unusual largeness in size or extent or number. <i>I have no illusions about the <b>immensity</b> of this task.</i>
<b>industrialist</b>	Someone who manages or has significant financial interest in an industrial enterprise. <i>The exploitation of child labour by nineteenth century <b>industrialists</b>.</i>
<b>libertarian</b>	An advocate of libertarianism. <i>He holds <b>libertarian</b> views on most social issues.</i>
<b>management</b>	The responsibility for and control of a company or organization. <i>He alleges that staff have been victims of <b>management</b> bullying.</i>
<b>mason</b>	A Freemason. <i>The chief <b>mason</b> at Westminster Abbey.</i>
<b>millionaire</b>	A person whose material wealth is valued at more than a million dollars. <i>He is now a <b>millionaire</b> several times over.</i>
<b>nationalist</b>	Relating to nationalists or nationalism. <i>A Basque <b>nationalist</b>.</i>
<b>politician</b>	A person who is professionally involved in politics, especially as a holder of an elected office. <i>A veteran communist <b>politician</b>.</i>
<b>profitable</b>	(of a business or activity) yielding profit or financial gain. <i>A professionally run and <b>profitable</b> company.</i>
<b>prosperous</b>	Very lively and profitable. <i>A <b>prosperous</b> family.</i>



- statesman** A man who is a respected leader in national or international affairs.  
*Guests included members of the European royal families, diplomats, and statesmen.*
- successful** Having achieved fame, wealth, or social status.  
*A **successful** attack on the town.*
- taking** The action or process of taking something.  
*Something inexpressibly **taking** in his manner.*
- thriving** Prosperous and growing; flourishing.  
*The **thriving** business George has built up.*
- winning** Having won.  
*A **winning** personality.*
