immensity	Unusual largeness in size or extent or number. I have no illusions about the immensity of this task.		
industrialist	Someone who manages or has significant financial interest in an industrial enterprise. The exploitation of child labour by nineteenth century industrialist s.		
libertarian	An advocate of libertarianism. He holds libertarian views on most social issues.		
management	The responsibility for and control of a company or organization. <i>He alleges that staff have been victims of management bullying.</i>		
mason	A Freemason. The chief mason at Westminster Abbey.		
millionaire	A person whose material wealth is valued at more than a million dollars. <i>He is now a millionaire several times over.</i>		
nationalist	Relating to nationalists or nationalism. A Basque nationalist .		
<u>politician</u>	A person who is professionally involved in politics, especially as a holder of an elected office. <i>A veteran communist</i> politician .
