business	Business concerns collectively. <i>He s not in my line of business.</i>
capitalist	Of or relating to capitalism or capitalists. <i>Capitalistic methods and incentives.</i>
demagogue	Rhetorically exploit (an issue) for political purposes in a way calculated to appeal to the desires and prejudices of ordinary people. <i>A gifted demagogue with particular skill in manipulating the press.</i>
diplomat	A person who deals tactfully with others.

diplomatist	An official engaged in international negotiations. A promoter in the entertainment industry.
entrepreneur	<i>The music entrepreneur pulled back from financing a screenplay Hopper had written.</i>
fetching	Attractive. <i>A fetching new hairstyle.</i>
financial	Involving financial matters. <i>He needs to pay serious attention to his financials particularly cash flow.</i>
financier	Conduct financial operations, often in an unethical manner.
flourishing	Very lively and profitable. <i>Flourishing businesses.</i>
freemason	A member of a widespread secret fraternal order pledged to mutual assistance and brotherly love.
immensely	To a great extent; extremely. <i>The president was immensely popular.</i>
immensity	Unusual largeness in size or extent or number. <i>I have no illusions about the immensity of this task.</i>
industrialist	Someone who manages or has significant financial interest in an industrial enterprise. <i>The exploitation of child labour by nineteenth century industrialists.</i>
libertarian	An advocate of libertarianism. <i>He holds libertarian views on most social issues.</i>
management	The responsibility for and control of a company or organization. <i>He alleges that staff have been victims of management bullying.</i>
mason	A Freemason. <i>The chief mason at Westminster Abbey.</i>
millionaire	A person whose material wealth is valued at more than a million dollars. <i>He is now a millionaire several times over.</i>
nationalist	Relating to nationalists or nationalism. <i>A Basque nationalist.</i>
politician	A person who is professionally involved in politics, especially as a holder of an elected office. <i>A veteran communist politician.</i>
profitable	(of a business or activity) yielding profit or financial gain. <i>A professionally run and profitable company.</i>
prosperous	Very lively and profitable. <i>A prosperous family.</i>

statesman	A man who is a respected leader in national or international affairs. <i>Guests included members of the European royal families, diplomats, and statesmen.</i>
successful	Having achieved fame, wealth, or social status. <i>A successful attack on the town.</i>
taking	The action or process of taking something. <i>Something inexpressibly taking in his manner.</i>
thriving	Prosperous and growing; flourishing. <i>The thriving business George has built up.</i>
winning	Having won. <i>A winning personality.</i>
