- *(of a woman) plump, with a full figure and large breasts.*
- *Having a large bosom and pleasing curves.*
- *(of a woman's body) having a large bosom and pleasing curves.*



## Synonyms of "Buxom" as an adjective (12 Words)

- curvaceous** Having an attractively curved shape (used especially of a woman or a woman's figure).  
*Stephanie's body became **curvaceous** and beautifully toned.*
- curvy** (of a woman's body) having a large bosom and pleasing curves.  
*A settee with only one **curvy** end.*
- full-bosomed** Having a large bosom and pleasing curves.
- sonsie** Having a large bosom and pleasing curves.
- sonsy** Having a large bosom and pleasing curves.
- stacked** (of a heel) made from thin layers of material glued one on top of the other.  
*The **stacked** shelves.*
- voluptuous** Relating to or characterized by luxury or sensual pleasure.  
*A **voluptuous** woman.*
- well-endowed** Having a large bosom and pleasing curves.

<b>zaftig</b>	(of a female body) healthily plump and vigorous. <i>A <b>zaftig</b> brunette.</i>
<b>zoftig</b>	Healthily plump and vigorous - Robt.A.Hamilton.

## Associations of "Buxom" (30 Words)

<b>adipose</b>	(especially of body tissue) used for the storage of fat. <i><b>Adipose</b> tissue constitutes the fat of meat.</i>
<b>avaricious</b>	Having or showing an extreme greed for wealth or material gain. <i>They are <b>avaricious</b> and will do anything for money.</i>
<b>bulbous</b>	Shaped like a bulb. <i>A <b>bulbous</b> nose.</i>
<b>chubby</b>	Plump and rounded. <i>A pretty child with <b>chubby</b> cheeks.</i>
<b>copious</b>	Large in number or quantity (especially of discourse). <i><b>Copious</b> provisions.</i>
<b>epicurean</b>	Of Epicurus or epicureanism. <i><b>Epicurean</b> pleasures.</i>
<b>fat</b>	A kind of body tissue containing stored fat that serves as a source of energy it also cushions and insulates vital organs. <i>A <b>fat</b> cigarette.</i>
<b>fatty</b>	Containing a large amount of fat. <i><b>Fatty</b> food.</i>
<b>fleshy</b>	(of a person or part of the body) having a substantial amount of flesh; plump. <i><b>Fleshy</b> greeny grey leaves.</i>
<b>gastronome</b>	A gourmet. <i><b>Gastronomes</b> will be fascinated by this guide to French cooking.</i>
<b>globose</b>	Having the shape of a sphere or ball. <i>The cells are generally <b>globose</b>.</i>
<b>gluttonous</b>	Excessively greedy. <i>A <b>gluttonous</b> debauch.</i>

<b>hedonistic</b>	Engaged in the pursuit of pleasure; sensually self-indulgent. <i>Lives of unending <b>hedonistic</b> delight.</i>
<b>obese</b>	Excessively fat. <i>One in ten people surveyed were <b>obese</b>.</i>
<b>overweight</b>	Invest in (a market sector, industry, etc.) to a greater than normal degree. <i>Try not to <b>overweight</b> the boxes.</i>
<b>paunch</b>	A thick strong mat used to give protection from chafing on a mast or spar. <i>His body was powerful and square with the beginnings of a <b>paunch</b>.</i>
<b>paunchy</b>	Having a large or protruding belly. <i>A slightly <b>paunchy</b> balding middle aged man.</i>
<b>plump</b>	Make fat or plump. <i>I was running from the kitchen to the living room <b>plumping</b> the cushions and getting drinks in place.</i>
<b>porcine</b>	Resembling swine; coarsely gluttonous or greedy. <i>His flushed <b>porcine</b> features.</i>
<b>portly</b>	Having a stout body; somewhat fat (used especially of a man). <i>Men are <b>portly</b> and women are stout.</i>
<b>protuberant</b>	Protruding; bulging. <i>His <b>protuberant</b> eyes fluttered open.</i>
<b>rotund</b>	Full and rich. <i>Huge stoves held great <b>rotund</b> cauldrons.</i>
<b>round</b>	Give a round shape to. <i>We'll <b>round</b> the weight up to the nearest kilo.</i>
<b>semicircle</b>	A set of objects arranged in a semicircle. <i>Chairs were in a <b>semicircle</b> round the hearth.</i>
<b>sensual</b>	Marked by the appetites and passions of the body. <i>Music is the only <b>sensual</b> pleasure without vice.</i>
<b>sensuous</b>	Relating to or affecting the senses rather than the intellect. <i>Her voice was rather deep but very <b>sensuous</b>.</i>
<b>stacked</b>	Arranged in a stack. <i>A <b>stacked</b> deck of a political system.</i>
<b>sybarite</b>	A person addicted to luxury and pleasures of the senses.
<b>voluptuous</b>	Curvaceous and sexually attractive (typically used of a woman). <i>Long curtains in <b>voluptuous</b> crimson velvet.</i>
