Definitions of "Cabinet" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “cabinet” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A small private room.*
- *A storage compartment for clothes and valuables; usually it has a lock.*
- *(in the US) a body of advisers to the president, composed of the heads of the executive departments of the government.*
- *A cupboard with shelves or drawers for storing or displaying articles.*
- *A piece of furniture resembling a cupboard with doors and shelves and drawers; for storage or display.*
- *(in the UK, Canada, and other Commonwealth countries) the committee of senior ministers responsible for controlling government policy.*
- *Housing for electronic instruments, as radio or television.*
- *A wooden box or piece of furniture housing a radio, television set, or speaker.*
- *Persons appointed by a head of state to head executive departments of government and act as official advisers.*



Synonyms of "Cabinet" as a noun (10 Words)

- administration** A method of tending to or managing the affairs of a some group of people (especially the group's business affairs).
*A career in arts **administration**.*
- console** A scientific instrument consisting of displays and an input device that an operator can use to monitor and control a system (especially a computer system).
*The bust of Napoleon stood on a **console**.*
- council** Denoting housing provided by a local council at a subsidized rent.
*That evening she held a family **council**.*
- counsellors** Someone who has supervisory duties at a summer camp.

- cupboard** A recess or piece of furniture with a door and typically shelves, used for storage.
*A broom **cupboard**.*
- executive** An executive committee or other body within an organization.
*An **executive** house.*
- locker** A device that locks something.
- ministry** Building where the business of a government ministry is transacted.
*He is studying for the **ministry**.*
- senior ministers** An undergraduate student during the year preceding graduation.
- storage locker** The act of storing something.



Usage Examples of "Cabinet" as a noun

- A cocktail cabinet.
- A cabinet meeting.



Associations of "Cabinet" (30 Words)

architect

A person who designs hardware, software, or networking applications and services of a specified type for a business or other organization.

*The great Norman **architect** of Durham Cathedral.*

bedroom

Denoting a small town or suburb whose residents commute to a nearby city.

*All parents dream of children who tidy their **bedrooms** without being asked.*

bookcase

A piece of furniture with shelves for storing books.

building

The occupants of a building.

*Workers in the **building** trades.*

closet

A tall piece of furniture that provides storage space for clothes; has a door and rails or hooks for hanging clothes.

*A **closet** smoker.*

<u>console</u>	An ornamental scroll-shaped bracket (especially one used to support a wall fixture. <i>You can console yourself with the thought that you did your best.</i>
cupboard	A small room (or recess) or cabinet used for storage space. <i>A broom cupboard.</i>
<u>demote</u>	Move (someone) to a lower position or rank, usually as a punishment. <i>The head of the army was demoted to deputy defence secretary.</i>
desk	A specified section of a newspaper or broadcasting organization. <i>He landed a job on the sports desk.</i>
drawer	A person who produces a drawing or design. <i>The banker would have rights as holder to pursue the drawer.</i>
filing	Preservation and methodical arrangement as of documents and papers etc. <i>I have some filing to do.</i>
fridge	A refrigerator in which the coolant is pumped around by an electric motor. <i>She put the carton of milk back in the fridge.</i>
furnishing	The act of decorating a house or room. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious furnishings.</i>
<u>furniture</u>	Furnishings that make a room or other area ready for occupancy. <i>The more sophisticated Mac furniture number wheels colour pickers and so on.</i>
<u>kitchen</u>	A set of fitments and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>Kitchen Swahili.</i>
rack	Place in or on a rack. <i>Moose have the most impressive racks of all the antlered animals.</i>
<u>rebuild</u>	An instance of rebuilding. <i>The Trust have recognized the hard work of all who were involved in this daunting rebuild.</i>
<u>reconstruct</u>	Build again. <i>A small area of painted Roman plaster has been reconstructed.</i>
<u>reconstruction</u>	A thing that has been rebuilt after being damaged or destroyed. <i>A reconstruction of the accident would be staged to try to discover the cause of the tragedy.</i>
remodel	Change the structure or form of (something, especially a building). <i>We are remodeling these rooms.</i>

reorganization	An extensive alteration of the structure of a corporation or government. <i>A committee was appointed to oversee the reorganization of the curriculum.</i>
reshuffle	Reorganize and assign posts to different people. <i>Youngman is requesting that Garcia reshuffle the cards.</i>
room	The people present in a room. <i>The whole room burst into an uproar of approval.</i>
shakeup	The imposition of a new organization; organizing differently (often involving extensive and drastic changes). <i>Top officials were forced out in the cabinet shakeup.</i>
sofa	An upholstered seat for more than one person. <i>Sofa cushions.</i>
stanchion	An upright bar, post, or frame forming a support or barrier.
wardrobe	Collection of clothing belonging to one person. <i>A wardrobe assistant.</i>
window	A framework of wood or metal that contains a glass windowpane and is built into a wall or roof to admit light or air. <i>The ball shattered the window.</i>
workbench	A strong worktable for a carpenter or mechanic.
wring	Break (an animal's neck) by twisting it forcibly. <i>I ll wring her neck when I lay hands on her.</i>
