## Cabinet as a Noun

### Definitions of "Cabinet" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “cabinet” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A small private room.*
- *A storage compartment for clothes and valuables; usually it has a lock.*
- *(in the US) a body of advisers to the president, composed of the heads of the executive departments of the government.*
- *A cupboard with shelves or drawers for storing or displaying articles.*
- *A piece of furniture resembling a cupboard with doors and shelves and drawers; for storage or display.*
- *(in the UK, Canada, and other Commonwealth countries) the committee of senior ministers responsible for controlling government policy.*
- *Housing for electronic instruments, as radio or television.*
- *A wooden box or piece of furniture housing a radio, television set, or speaker.*
- *Persons appointed by a head of state to head executive departments of government and act as official advisers.*



## Synonyms of "Cabinet" as a noun (10 Words)

<b>administration</b>	A method of tending to or managing the affairs of a some group of people (especially the group's business affairs). <i>A career in arts <b>administration</b>.</i>
<b><u>console</u></b>	A scientific instrument consisting of displays and an input device that an operator can use to monitor and control a system (especially a computer system). <i>The bust of Napoleon stood on a <b>console</b>.</i>
<b><u>council</u></b>	Denoting housing provided by a local council at a subsidized rent. <i>That evening she held a family <b>council</b>.</i>
<b>counsellors</b>	Someone who has supervisory duties at a summer camp.



- cupboard** A recess or piece of furniture with a door and typically shelves, used for storage.  
*A broom **cupboard**.*
- executive** An executive committee or other body within an organization.  
*An **executive** house.*
- locker** A device that locks something.
- ministry** Building where the business of a government ministry is transacted.  
*He is studying for the **ministry**.*
- senior ministers** An undergraduate student during the year preceding graduation.
- storage locker** The act of storing something.

## Associations of "Cabinet" (30 Words)

### architect

A person who designs hardware, software, or networking applications and services of a specified type for a business or other organization.

*The great Norman **architect** of Durham Cathedral.*

### bedroom

Denoting a small town or suburb whose residents commute to a nearby city.

*All parents dream of children who tidy their **bedrooms** without being asked.*

### **bookcase**

A piece of furniture with shelves for storing books.

### **building**

The occupants of a building.

*Workers in the **building** trades.*

### closet

A tall piece of furniture that provides storage space for clothes; has a door and rails or hooks for hanging clothes.

*A **closet** smoker.*

<b><u>console</u></b>	An ornamental scroll-shaped bracket (especially one used to support a wall fixture. <i>You can <b>console</b> yourself with the thought that you did your best.</i>
<b>cupboard</b>	A small room (or recess) or cabinet used for storage space. <i>A broom <b>cupboard</b>.</i>
<b><u>demote</u></b>	Move (someone) to a lower position or rank, usually as a punishment. <i>The head of the army was <b>demoted</b> to deputy defence secretary.</i>
<b>desk</b>	A specified section of a newspaper or broadcasting organization. <i>He landed a job on the sports <b>desk</b>.</i>
<b>drawer</b>	A person who produces a drawing or design. <i>The banker would have rights as holder to pursue the <b>drawer</b>.</i>
<b>filing</b>	Preservation and methodical arrangement as of documents and papers etc. <i>I have some <b>filing</b> to do.</i>
<b>fridge</b>	A refrigerator in which the coolant is pumped around by an electric motor. <i>She put the carton of milk back in the <b>fridge</b>.</i>
<b>furnishing</b>	The act of decorating a house or room. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious <b>furnishings</b>.</i>
<b><u>furniture</u></b>	Furnishings that make a room or other area ready for occupancy. <i>The more sophisticated Mac <b>furniture</b> number wheels colour pickers and so on.</i>
<b><u>kitchen</u></b>	A set of fitments and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i><b>Kitchen</b> Swahili.</i>
<b>rack</b>	Place in or on a rack. <i>Moose have the most impressive <b>racks</b> of all the antlered animals.</i>
<b><u>rebuild</u></b>	An instance of rebuilding. <i>The Trust have recognized the hard work of all who were involved in this daunting <b>rebuild</b>.</i>
<b><u>reconstruct</u></b>	Build again. <i>A small area of painted Roman plaster has been <b>reconstructed</b>.</i>
<b><u>reconstruction</u></b>	A thing that has been rebuilt after being damaged or destroyed. <i>A <b>reconstruction</b> of the accident would be staged to try to discover the cause of the tragedy.</i>
<b>remodel</b>	Change the structure or form of (something, especially a building). <i>We are <b>remodeling</b> these rooms.</i>

<b>reorganization</b>	An extensive alteration of the structure of a corporation or government. <i>A committee was appointed to oversee the <b>reorganization</b> of the curriculum.</i>
<b>reshuffle</b>	Reorganize and assign posts to different people. <i>Youngman is requesting that Garcia <b>reshuffle</b> the cards.</i>
<b><u>room</u></b>	The people present in a room. <i>The whole <b>room</b> burst into an uproar of approval.</i>
<b>shakeup</b>	The imposition of a new organization; organizing differently (often involving extensive and drastic changes). <i>Top officials were forced out in the cabinet <b>shakeup</b>.</i>
<b><u>sofa</u></b>	An upholstered seat for more than one person. <i><b>Sofa</b> cushions.</i>
<b>stanchion</b>	An upright bar, post, or frame forming a support or barrier.
<b><u>wardrobe</u></b>	Collection of clothing belonging to one person. <i>A <b>wardrobe</b> assistant.</i>
<b><u>window</u></b>	A framework of wood or metal that contains a glass windowpane and is built into a wall or roof to admit light or air. <i>The ball shattered the <b>window</b>.</i>
<b>workbench</b>	A strong worktable for a carpenter or mechanic.
<b>wring</b>	Break (an animal's neck) by twisting it forcibly. <i>I ll <b>wring</b> her neck when I lay hands on her.</i>
