- A piece of furniture resembling a cupboard with doors and shelves and drawers; for storage or display.
- (in the UK, Canada, and other Commonwealth countries) the committee of senior ministers responsible for controlling government policy.
- Housing for electronic instruments, as radio or television.
- A wooden box or piece of furniture housing a radio, television set, or speaker.
- Persons appointed by a head of state to head executive departments of government and act as official advisers.
