herbaceous Characteristic of a nonwoody herb or plant part.

A thing that resembles a leaf in being flat and thin.

Used in names of other plants with flowers or leaves similar to those of the

lily e g arum lily.



mesquite

A spiny tree or shrub of the pea family, native to arid regions of south-western

US and Mexico. It yields useful timber, tanbark, medicinal products, and

edible pods. The timber is used for fencing and flooring, and burned in

barbecues as flavouring.

Any of numerous plants of the orchid family usually having flowers of unusual

shapes and beautiful colors.

outback
Inaccessible and sparsely populated.
The outback of Ontario.

petiole The stalk that joins a leaf to a stem.

Cover or supply an area of land with plants.

They built a large **plant** to manufacture automobiles.

Having a sharpened or tapered tip or end.

pointed His face tapers to a pointed chin.

An insect or other agent that conveys pollen to a plant and so allows

pollinator fertilization.

Bees are effective **pollinator**s of fruit and vegetables.

prickly Covered in prickles.

She came across as **prickly** and generally difficult.

Used in names of other plants whose flowers resemble roses e g Christmas

rose rose of Sharon.

A warm flush now **rose**d her hitherto blue cheeks.

Used in names of birds with partly pink plumage e g roseate tern.

roseate His letters home give a very good although somewhat too **roseate** idea of how

he lived.

shrub A woody plant which is smaller than a tree and has several main stems arising

at or near the ground.

spinous Shaped like a spine or thorn.

The dorsal fin is **spinous**.

spiny Full of or covered with prickles.

A **spiny** problem.

A stalklike support for a sessile animal or for an organ in an animal.

Stalk the woods for deer.

sting Cause a sharp or stinging pain or discomfort.

He felt the stinging of nettles.

thorn A thorny bush shrub or tree especially a hawthorn.

He s a **thorn** in my flesh.

Having many thorns or thorn bushes. A **thorny** problem for our team to solve.

vegetation

The action or process of vegetating.

The chalk cliffs are mainly sheer with little **vegetation**.
