Past Tense	<b>calendered</b>
Present Participle	<b>calendering</b>
Past Participle	<b>calendered</b>

## Conjugate Calender

**Calender in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **calender**                      We **calender**  
You **calender**                  You **calender**  
He/She/It **calenders**      They **calender**

**Calender in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am calendering**              We **are calendering**  
You **are calendering**        You **are calendering**  
He/She/It **is calendering**    They **are calendering**

**Calender in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have calendered**              We **have calendered**  
You **have calendered**        You **have calendered**  
He/She/It **has calendered**    They **have calendered**

**Calender in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been calendering**        We **have been calendering**  
You **have been calendering**    You **have been calendering**  
He/She/It **has been calendering**    They **have been calendering**

**Calender in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **calendered**                      We **calendered**  
You **calendered**                  You **calendered**  
He/She/It **calendered**        They **calendered**

**Calender in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was calendering      We were calendering  
You were calendering      You were calendering  
He/She/It was calendering      They were calendering

**Calender in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had calendered      We had calendered  
You had calendered      You had calendered  
He/She/It had calendered      They had calendered

**Calender in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been calendering      We had been calendering  
You had been calendering      You had been calendering  
He/She/It had been calendering      They had been calendering

**Calender in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will calender      We will calender  
You will calender      You will calender  
He/She/It will calender      They will calender

**Calender in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be calendering      We will be calendering  
You will be calendering      You will be calendering  
He/She/It will be calendering      They will be calendering

**Calender in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have calendered**

**We will have calendered**

**You will have calendered**

**You will have calendered**

**He/She/It will have calendered** **They will have calendered**

**Calender in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been calendering**

**We will have been calendering**

**You will have been calendering**

**You will have been calendering**

**He/She/It will have been calendering** **They will have been calendering**
