The public address system in the hospital was used for **paging**.

Get or try to get into communication with someone by telephone. **phone**

He **phone**d her at work.

Restore to the previous state or rank. reinstate

The union threatened strike action if Owen was not **reinstate**d.

A person who has been repatriated. repatriate

Foreign firms would be permitted to **repatriate** all profits.

The sound of a bell ringing.

ring **Ring** birds.

Call in an official matter, such as to attend court. **summon**

Summon a lawyer.

Serve someone with a summons.
