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<u>Associations of "Campus" (30 Words)</u>

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<u>absenteeism</u>	The practice of regularly staying away from work or school without good reason. High levels of absenteeism caused by low job motivation.
<u>academy</u>	A school for special training. A police academy .
attendance	The number of people that are present. <i>Attendance</i> was up by 50 per cent.
bursar	A student who holds a bursary.
college	The teaching staff and students of a college considered collectively. <i>Colleges of further education.</i>
diploma	A certificate awarded by an educational establishment to show that someone has successfully completed a course of study.
<u>dorm</u>	A dormitory.
<u>educate</u>	Give intellectual, moral, and social instruction to (someone), typically at a school or university. We must educate our youngsters better.
<u>educator</u>	Someone who educates young people. The perspective of a professional educator .
enrol	Recruit (someone) to perform a service. <i>The endowment of religious houses cannot be measured simply by the</i> <i>licences</i> enrol led in chancery.
<u>enrollment</u>	The act of enrolling.
grad	A person who has received a degree from a school (high school or college or university.
graduation	An academic exercise in which diplomas are conferred. The ruler had 16 graduation s per inch.
headmaster	Presiding officer of a school.



homeroom	A classroom in which a group of students assembles daily with the same teacher before dispersing to other classes.
matriculate	A person who has matriculated. They had recently matriculate d as undergraduates at Jesus College.
pedagogics	The principles and methods of instruction.
pedagogy	The method and practice of teaching, especially as an academic subject or theoretical concept. Pedagogy is recognized as an important profession.
polytechnic	An institution of higher education offering courses at degree level or below, especially in vocational subjects.
pupil	A young person attending school (up through senior high school. They are former pupil s of the school.
<u>schooling</u>	The process of being formally educated at a school. <i>Schooling fences.</i>
schoolmaster	An experienced horse that is used to train or give confidence to inexperienced riders or horses.
semester	Half a year; a period of 6 months. The opening week of Harvard s autumn semester .
studying	Reading carefully with intent to remember.
teach	Work as a teacher. I ll teach you to throw rocks at my windows.
teaching	The activities of educating or instructing; activities that impart knowledge or skill. <i>He prepared for teaching while still in college.</i>
<u>trainee</u>	A person undergoing training for a particular job or profession. <i>Trainee</i> solicitors.
undergraduate	Denoting or relating to an undergraduate. Undergraduate students.
<u>university</u>	The body of faculty and students at a university. <i>His daughter is at university.</i>
valedictorian	(in North America) a student who delivers the valedictory at a graduation ceremony.
