He/She/It is canaling or canalling
They are canaling or canalling

Canal in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have canaled or canalled
You have canaled or canalled
You have canaled or canalled
He/She/It has canaled or canalled
They have canaled or canalled

Canal in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been canaling or canalling
You have been canaling or canalling
You have been canaling or canalling
He/She/It has been canaling or canalling
They have been canaling or canalling

Canal in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I canaled or canalled
You canaled or canalled
You canaled or canalled
He/She/It canaled or canalled

Canal in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

You will canal You will canal
He/She/It will canal They will canal

Canal in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

He/She/It will be canaling or canalling
They will be canaling or canalling
