Past Tense	<b>canned</b>
Present Participle	<b>canning</b>
Past Participle	<b>canned</b>

**Singular**

I **can**

We **can**

You **can**

You **can**

He/She/It **can** They **can**

## **Can in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am canning**

We **are canning**

You **are canning**

You **are canning**

He/She/It **is canning** They **are canning**

## **Can in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have canned**

We **have canned**

You **have canned**

You **have canned**

He/She/It **has canned** They **have canned**

## **Can in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been canning**

We **have been canning**

You **have been canning**

You **have been canning**

He/She/It **has been canning** They **have been canning**

## **Can in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **canned**

We **canned**

You **canned**

You **canned**

He/She/It **canned** They **canned**

## **Can in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I was cancaning</b>	<b>We were cancaning</b>
<b>You were cancaning</b>	<b>You were cancaning</b>
<b>He/She/It was cancaning</b>	<b>They were cancaning</b>

**Cancan in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had cancanned</b>	<b>We had cancanned</b>
<b>You had cancanned</b>	<b>You had cancanned</b>
<b>He/She/It had cancanned</b>	<b>They had cancanned</b>

**Cancan in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been cancaning</b>	<b>We had been cancaning</b>
<b>You had been cancaning</b>	<b>You had been cancaning</b>
<b>He/She/It had been cancaning</b>	<b>They had been cancaning</b>

**Cancan in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>I will cancan</b>	<b>We will cancan</b>
<b>You will cancan</b>	<b>You will cancan</b>
<b>He/She/It will cancan</b>	<b>They will cancan</b>

**Cancan in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will be cancaning</b>	<b>We will be cancaning</b>
<b>You will be cancaning</b>	<b>You will be cancaning</b>
<b>He/She/It will be cancaning</b>	<b>They will be cancaning</b>

**Cancan in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have cancelled**

**We will have cancelled**

**You will have cancelled**

**You will have cancelled**

**He/She/It will have cancelled**

**They will have cancelled**

**Cancel in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been cancelling**

**We will have been cancelling**

**You will have been cancelling**

**You will have been cancelling**

**He/She/It will have been cancelling**

**They will have been cancelling**
