Present Participle cancelling (commonwealth), canceling (american)

# **Conjugate Cancel**

**Cancel in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense** 



Singular Plural
I cancel We cancel
You cancel You cancel
He/She/It cancels They cancel

## **Cancel in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular Plural

I am cancelling (commonwealth), We are cancelling (commonwealth),

canceling (american) canceling (american)

You are cancelling (commonwealth), You are cancelling (commonwealth),

canceling (american) canceling (american)

He/She/It is cancelling (commonwealth), They are cancelling (commonwealth),

canceling (american) canceling (american)

**Singular** Plural

I have cancelled (commonwealth), We have cancelled (commonwealth),

canceled (american) canceled (american)

You have cancelled (commonwealth), You have cancelled (commonwealth),

They have been cancelling
