The Forms of Cancerate

Infinitive to cancerate

Present Tense cancerate / cancerates

Past Tense cancerated
Present Participle cancerating
Past Participle cancerated

Conjugate Cancerate

Cancerate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I cancerate We cancerate
You cancerate You cancerate
He/She/It cancerates They cancerate

Cancerate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am cancerating We are cancerating
You are cancerating
He/She/It is cancerating They are cancerating

Cancerate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have cancerated We have cancerated You have cancerated He/She/It has cancerated They have cancerated

Cancerate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been cancerating
You have been cancerating
He/She/It has been cancerating
They have been cancerating

Cancerate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I cancerated We cancerated
You cancerated You cancerated

He/She/It cancerated They cancerated

Cancerate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was cancerating We were cancerating
You were cancerating
He/She/It was cancerating They were cancerating

Cancerate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had cancerated We had cancerated You had cancerated He/She/It had cancerated They had cancerated

Cancerate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been cancerating
You had been cancerating
You had been cancerating
He/She/It had been cancerating
They had been cancerating

Cancerate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will cancerate
You will cancerate
He/She/It will cancerate
They will cancerate

Cancerate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be cancerating
You will be cancerating
He/She/It will be cancerating
They will be cancerating

Cancerate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have cancerated We will have cancerated You will have cancerated He/She/It will have cancerated They will have cancerated

Cancerate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been cancerating
You will have been cancerating
He/She/It will have been cancerating
They will have been cancerating
