Candy as a Noun

Definitions of "Candy" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “candy” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A rich sweet made of flavored sugar and often combined with fruit or nuts.*
- *Sweets; confectionery.*
- *Sugar crystallized by repeated boiling and slow evaporation.*



Synonyms of "Candy" as a noun (3 Words)

- bonbons** A candy that usually has a center of fondant or fruit or nuts coated in chocolate.
- confect** A rich sweet made of flavored sugar and often combined with fruit or nuts.
- confectionery** A shop that sells sweets and chocolates.
A *confectionery* company offering hand made chocolates.



Usage Examples of "Candy" as a noun

- *People sat eating popcorn and candy.*
- *A candy bar.*
- *Pink and yellow candies.*
- *Making candy at home is not difficult—the key is cooking the syrup to the right temperature.*



Candy as a Verb

Definitions of "Candy" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "candy" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Preserve (fruit, nuts, etc.) by coating and saturating it with a sugar syrup.*

- Coat with something sweet, such as a hard sugar glaze.



Synonyms of "Candy" as a verb (2 Words)

- glaze** Coat with something sweet such as a hard sugar glaze.
*The potter **glazed** the dishes.*
- sugarcoat** Cause to appear more pleasant or appealing.
*The mayor did not **sugarcoat** the reality of the tax cuts.*



Usage Examples of "Candy" as a verb

- *I candied the walnuts with maple syrup.*



Associations of "Candy" (30 Words)

bread	The bread or wafer used in the Eucharist. <i>Italian breads.</i>
cake	Form a coat over. <i>A starter of goat s cheese and potato cakes.</i>
chocolate	Hot chocolate. <i>The former Great Western colours of chocolate and cream.</i>
cinnamon	The tree which yields cinnamon. <i>He wore a short sleeved shirt and pale cinnamon slacks.</i>
cocoa	A hot drink made from cocoa powder mixed with milk or water.
coffee	The shrub which yields coffee seeds native to the Old World tropics. <i>A coffee pot.</i>
confection	Make into a confection. <i>Therese was magnificent in a swirling confection of crimson.</i>
confectionery	A shop that sells sweets and chocolates. <i>A confectionery company offering hand made chocolates.</i>

dessert	A dish served as the last course of a meal. <i>A dessert of chocolate mousse.</i>
flavour	A substance used to alter or enhance the taste of food or drink a flavouring. <i>Whitewashed walls and red roof tiles gave the resort a Mediterranean flavour.</i>
flour	Sprinkle something especially a work surface or cooking utensil with a thin layer of flour. <i>Manioc flour.</i>
glaze	Coat with a glaze. <i>New potatoes which had been glazed in mint flavoured butter.</i>
goody	A good or favoured person, especially a hero in a book, film, etc.
homemade	Made or produced in the home or by yourself. <i>Homemade bread.</i>
honey	Sweeten with honey. <i>It s one honey of an adaptation.</i>
mill	Grind something in a mill. <i>Hard wheats are easily milled into white flour.</i>
mint	A candy that is flavored with a mint oil. <i>Plant mint in a large pot with drainage holes.</i>
molasses	Syrup used in baking and to pour over food.
powder	A cosmetic in the form of powder applied to a person s face with a brush or soft pad. <i>In Aspen blue skies and good powder drew in record numbers.</i>
pudding	A sweet or savoury steamed dish made with suet and flour. <i>Corn pudding.</i>
saccharine	Relating to or containing sugar; sugary. <i>Saccharine music.</i>
shop	A place where things are manufactured or repaired a workshop. <i>A barber s shop.</i>
sifter	A household sieve (as for flour).
sugar	Sweeten with sugar. <i>A spoonful of sugar.</i>
sweet	Having a sweet nature befitting an angel or cherub. <i>My sweet love.</i>
sweetener	Anything that serves as an enticement. <i>Diet drinks contain artificial sweeteners like saccharin.</i>

- tea** A drink made from the infused leaves fruits or flowers of plants other than tea.
*Fish and chips for **tea**.*
- treacle** Syrup of a golden-yellow colour; golden syrup.
*Enough of this **treacle** let s get back to business.*
- vanilla** Ice cream flavoured with vanilla.
*His sex life is totally **vanilla**.*
