- A rich sweet made of flavored sugar and often combined with fruit or nuts.
- *Sweets;* confectionery.
- Sugar crystallized by repeated boiling and slow evaporation.

Definitions of "Candy" as a verb

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "candy" as a verb can have the following definitions:

• Preserve (fruit, nuts, etc.) by coating and saturating it with a sugar syrup.



• Coat with something sweet, such as a hard sugar glaze.
