I am caning We are caning
You are caning You are caning
He/She/It is caning They are caning

Cane in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural
I have caned We have caned
You have caned You have caned
He/She/It has caned They have caned

Cane in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been caning We have been caning

You have been caning You have been caning

He/She/It has been caning They have been caning

Cane in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was caning We were caning
You were caning
He/She/It was caning They were caning

Cane in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural
I had caned We had caned
You had caned You had caned
He/She/It had caned They had caned

Cane in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been caning
You had been caning
He/She/It had been caning
They had been caning

Cane in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will cane We will cane
You will cane You will cane
He/She/It will cane They will cane

Cane in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be caning
You will be caning
He/She/It will be caning
They will be caning

Cane in Future Perfect Tense

I will have caned
You will have caned
He/She/It will have caned
They will have caned

I will have been caning
You will have been caning
He/She/It will have been caning
They will have been caning
