Past Tense	canoed
Present Participle	canoeing
Past Participle	canoed

Conjugate Canoe

Canoe in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **canoe** We **canoe**
You **canoe** You **canoe**
He/She/It **canoed** They **canoe**

Canoe in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am canoeing** We **are canoeing**
You **are canoeing** You **are canoeing**
He/She/It **is canoeing** They **are canoeing**

Canoe in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have canoed** We **have canoed**
You **have canoed** You **have canoed**
He/She/It **has canoed** They **have canoed**

Canoe in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been canoeing** We **have been canoeing**
You **have been canoeing** You **have been canoeing**
He/She/It **has been canoeing** They **have been canoeing**

Canoe in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **canoed** We **canoed**
You **canoed** You **canoed**
He/She/It **canoed** They **canoed**

Canoe in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was canoeing We were canoeing
You were canoeing You were canoeing
He/She/It was canoeing They were canoeing

Canoe in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had canoed We had canoed
You had canoed You had canoed
He/She/It had canoed They had canoed

Canoe in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been canoeing We had been canoeing
You had been canoeing You had been canoeing
He/She/It had been canoeing They had been canoeing

Canoe in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will canoe We will canoe
You will canoe You will canoe
He/She/It will canoe They will canoe

Canoe in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be canoeing We will be canoeing
You will be canoeing You will be canoeing
He/She/It will be canoeing They will be canoeing

Canoe in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have canoed

We will have canoed

You will have canoed

You will have canoed

He/She/It will have canoed

They will have canoed

Canoe in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been canoeing

We will have been canoeing

You will have been canoeing

You will have been canoeing

He/She/It will have been canoeing

They will have been canoeing
