Canter in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am cantering We are cantering
You are cantering You are cantering
He/She/It is cantering They are cantering

Canter in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have cantered We have cantered You have cantered You have cantered He/She/It has cantered They have cantered

Canter in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been cantering
You have been cantering
He/She/It has been cantering
They have been cantering

Canter in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I cantered We cantered
You cantered You cantered
He/She/It cantered They cantered

Canter in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was cantering We were cantering
You were cantering You were cantering
He/She/It was cantering They were cantering

Canter in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had cantered We had cantered
You had cantered You had cantered
He/She/It had cantered They had cantered

Canter in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been cantering
You had been cantering
He/She/It had been cantering
They had been cantering

Canter in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will canter We will canter

You will canter

He/She/It will canter They will canter

Canter in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be cantering
You will be cantering
He/She/It will be cantering
They will be cantering

Canter in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have cantered We will have cantered You will have cantered He/She/It will have cantered They will have cantered

Canter in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been cantering
You will have been cantering
You will have been cantering
He/She/It will have been cantering
They will have been cantering
