Present Tense	<b>cap / caps</b>
Past Tense	<b>capped</b>
Present Participle	<b>capping</b>
Past Participle	<b>capped</b>

## Conjugate Cap

**Cap in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>cap</b>	We <b>cap</b>
You <b>cap</b>	You <b>cap</b>
He/She/It <b>caps</b>	They <b>cap</b>

## **Cap in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am capping</b>	We <b>are capping</b>
You <b>are capping</b>	You <b>are capping</b>
He/She/It <b>is capping</b>	They <b>are capping</b>

## **Cap in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have capped</b>	We <b>have capped</b>
You <b>have capped</b>	You <b>have capped</b>
He/She/It <b>has capped</b>	They <b>have capped</b>

## **Cap in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been capping</b>	We <b>have been capping</b>
You <b>have been capping</b>	You <b>have been capping</b>
He/She/It <b>has been capping</b>	They <b>have been capping</b>

## **Cap in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>capped</b>	We <b>capped</b>
You <b>capped</b>	You <b>capped</b>
He/She/It <b>capped</b>	They <b>capped</b>

## **Cap in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

I <b>was capping</b>	We <b>were capping</b>
You <b>were capping</b>	You <b>were capping</b>
He/She/It <b>was capping</b>	They <b>were capping</b>

**Cap in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>had capped</b>	We <b>had capped</b>
You <b>had capped</b>	You <b>had capped</b>
He/She/It <b>had capped</b>	They <b>had capped</b>

**Cap in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>had been capping</b>	We <b>had been capping</b>
You <b>had been capping</b>	You <b>had been capping</b>
He/She/It <b>had been capping</b>	They <b>had been capping</b>

**Cap in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>will cap</b>	We <b>will cap</b>
You <b>will cap</b>	You <b>will cap</b>
He/She/It <b>will cap</b>	They <b>will cap</b>

**Cap in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

I <b>will be capping</b>	We <b>will be capping</b>
You <b>will be capping</b>	You <b>will be capping</b>
He/She/It <b>will be capping</b>	They <b>will be capping</b>

**I will have capped**

**We will have capped**

**You will have capped**

**You will have capped**

**He/She/It will have capped**

**They will have capped**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been capping**

**We will have been capping**

**You will have been capping**

**You will have been capping**

**He/She/It will have been capping**

**They will have been capping**
