Capon in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **capon** We **capon**
You **capon** You **capon**
He/She/It **capons** They **capon**

Capon in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am caponing** We **are caponing**
You **are caponing** You **are caponing**
He/She/It **is caponing** They **are caponing**

Capon in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have caponed** We **have caponed**
You **have caponed** You **have caponed**
He/She/It **has caponed** They **have caponed**

Capon in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been caponing** We **have been caponing**
You **have been caponing** You **have been caponing**
He/She/It **has been caponing** They **have been caponing**

Capon in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **caponed** We **caponed**
You **caponed** You **caponed**
He/She/It **caponed** They **caponed**

Capon in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was caponing	We were caponing
You were caponing	You were caponing
He/She/It was caponing	They were caponing

Capon in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had caponed	We had caponed
You had caponed	You had caponed
He/She/It had caponed	They had caponed

Capon in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been caponing	We had been caponing
You had been caponing	You had been caponing
He/She/It had been caponing	They had been caponing

Capon in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will capon	We will capon
You will capon	You will capon
He/She/It will capon	They will capon

Capon in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be caponing	We will be caponing
You will be caponing	You will be caponing
He/She/It will be caponing	They will be caponing

Capon in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have caponed

We will have caponed

You will have caponed

You will have caponed

He/She/It will have caponed

They will have caponed

Capon in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been caponing

We will have been caponing

You will have been caponing

You will have been caponing

He/She/It will have been caponing

They will have been caponing
