- *A person who is responsible for attending to the needs of a child or dependent adult.*

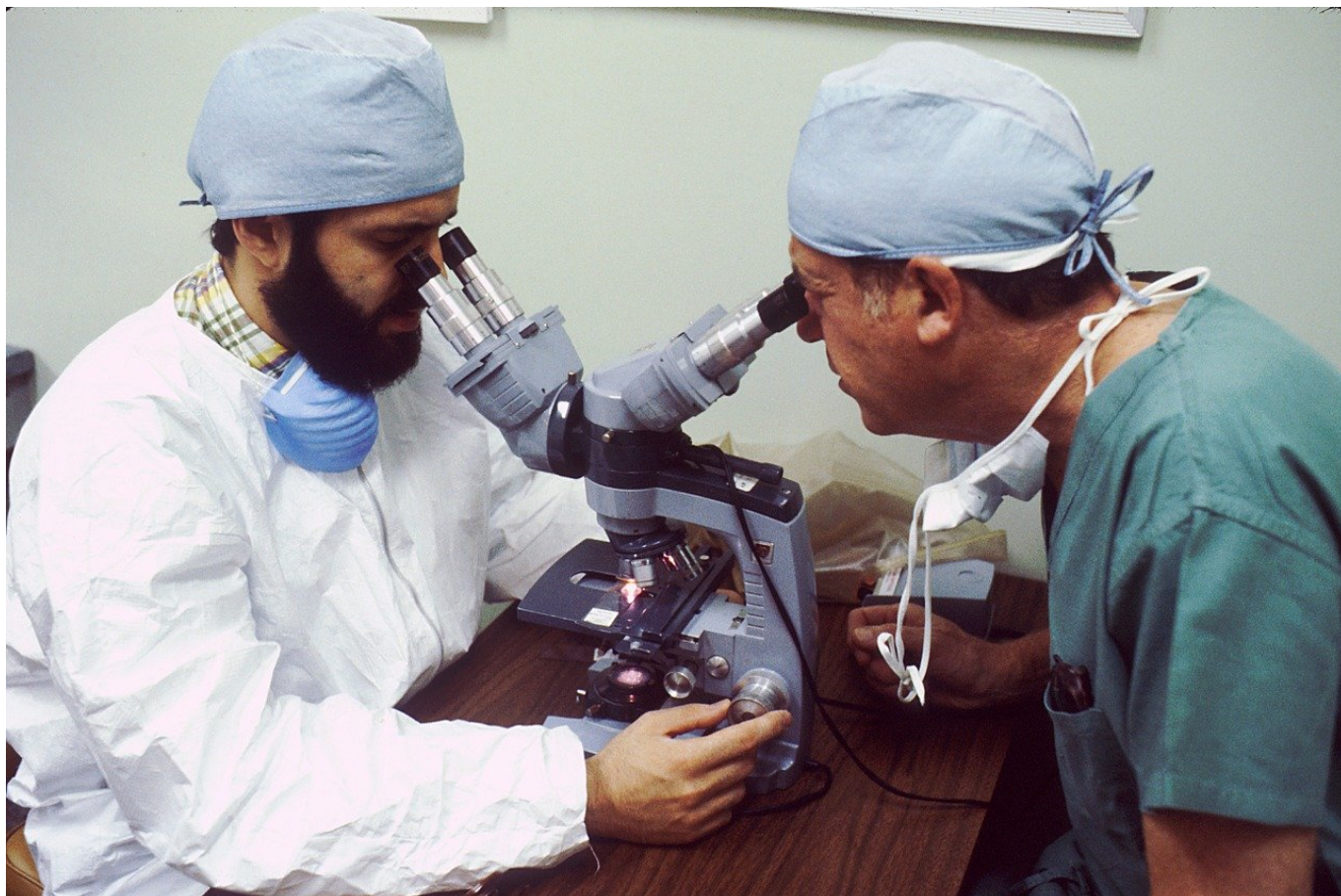


Synonyms of "Caregiver" as a noun (4 Words)

health professional A healthy state of wellbeing free from disease.

primary care provider Coil forming the part of an electrical circuit such that changing current in it induces a current in a neighboring circuit.

gramps	The father of your father or mother.

grandchild	A child of your son or daughter.
grandfather	The father of your father or mother. <i>Freud is often called the grandfather of psychoanalysis.</i>
grandma	One's grandmother. Grandma Wendy.
grandmother	The mother of your father or mother. <i>My grandmother is ill.</i>
grandpa	The father of your father or mother.
grandparent	A parent of your father or mother. <i>It must be a great blessing to have Chloe's grandparents living nearby.</i>
<u>homemaker</u>	A wife who manages a household while her husband earns the family income.
maternal	Related through the mother's side of the family. <i>My maternal grandmother.</i>
matriarch	A female head of a family or tribe. <i>A domineering matriarch.</i>
matriarchy	The state of being an older, powerful woman in a family or group. <i>A matriarchy run by morally superior women.</i>
mom	Informal terms for a mother. <i>My mom gave us each a slice of pizza.</i>
mommy	One's mother (chiefly as a child's term).
<u>mother</u>	A term of address for a mother superior. <i>A mother of three.</i>
nan	The mother of your father or mother.
<u>parent</u>	Be or act as a parent to a child. <i>God's hand had written in the hearts of our first parents all the rules of good.</i>
parental	Designating the generation of organisms from which hybrid offspring are produced. <i>I may revisit this diner if the parentals are in town.</i>
paternal	Relating to or characteristic of or befitting a parent. <i>My elders in the newsroom kept a paternal eye on me.</i>
paternity	(especially in legal contexts) the state of being someone's father. <i>He refused to admit paternity of the child.</i>
patriarchy	A society or community organized on patriarchal lines. <i>We live in a patriarchy.</i>

- progeny** A descendant or the descendants of a person, animal, or plant; offspring.
*Shorthorn cattle are highly effective in bestowing their characteristics on their **progeny**.*
- sister** A title given to a nun (and used as a form of address).
*I had nine brothers and **sisters**.*
- sisterhood** The relationship between sisters.
*Canadian feminists acknowledge their **sisterhood** with women around the globe.*
- widower** A man whose spouse is often away participating in a specified sport or activity.
*Her new found passion has turned me into a tennis **widower**.*
