Associations of "Carrion" (30 Words)

blubber	Cry or whine with snuffling. <i>My six pack is quickly being covered in blubber.</i>
carcass	The dead body of an animal especially one slaughtered and dressed for food. <i>She saw the mud covered carcass of a sheep.</i>
caribou	Arctic deer with large antlers in both sexes called reindeer in Eurasia and caribou in North America.
carnivore	A mammal of the order Carnivora. <i>Terrestrial carnivores have four or five clawed digits on each limb.</i>
corpse	Spoil a piece of acting by forgetting one’s lines or laughing uncontrollably. <i>He believed that fascism would revive the corpse of Europe.</i>
debris	Scattered pieces of rubbish or remains. <i>Workmen were clearing the roads of the debris from shattered buildings.</i>
dissolution	The process of going into solution. <i>The dissolution of their marriage.</i>
extravagance	The trait of spending extravagantly. <i>We were surprised by the extravagance of his description.</i>
ferment	Cause to undergo fermentation. <i>Her mind ferments.</i>
fermentation	The fermentation process involved in the making of beers wines and spirits in which sugars are converted to ethyl alcohol. <i>I had found Paris in high fermentation.</i>
flesh	Remove the flesh adhering to a skin or hide. <i>She gasped as the cold water hit her flesh.</i>
fungi	The taxonomic kingdom including yeast, molds, smuts, mushrooms, and toadstools; distinct from the green plants.

garbage	Worthless or meaningless material or ideas; rubbish. <i>Garbage littered the estate.</i>
germ	An initial stage from which something may develop. <i>The germ of a brilliant idea.</i>
hamburger	Minced beef.
meat	The flesh of a person's body. <i>Pieces of meat.</i>
multicellular	Consisting of many cells. <i>Multicellular organisms.</i>
mutton	The flesh of fully grown sheep used as food. <i>A leg of mutton.</i>
organism	The material structure of an organism. <i>The Church is a divinely constituted organism.</i>
pork	Gorge oneself with food. <i>Roast pork.</i>
putrescent	Undergoing the process of decay; rotting. <i>A trail lined by putrescent carcasses.</i>
putrid	In an advanced state of decomposition and having a foul odor- Somerset Maugham. <i>The putrid atmosphere of the court.</i>
rot	Liver rot in sheep. <i>The leaves were turning black with rot.</i>
scavenger	A person who searches for and collects discarded items. <i>A reputation as a scavenger of discarded odds and ends.</i>
spoilage	The amount that has spoiled.
steak	A thick slice of steak or other high quality meat or fish. <i>A salmon steak.</i>
uncooked	Not cooked. <i>Frozen ready meals may be completely uncooked.</i>
unicellular	(of an evolutionary or developmental stage) characterized by the formation or presence of a single cell or cells. <i>Patches of unicellular algae.</i>
waste	Run off as waste. <i>Ensure that waste materials are disposed of responsibly.</i>
