<u>blubber</u>	Cry or whine with snuffling. My six pack is quickly being covered in blubber .
carcass	The dead body of an animal especially one slaughtered and dressed for food. She saw the mud covered carcass of a sheep.
caribou	Arctic deer with large antlers in both sexes called reindeer in Eurasia and caribou in North America.
carnivore	A mammal of the order Carnivora. Terrestrial carnivore s have four or five clawed digits on each limb.
corpse	Spoil a piece of acting by forgetting one's lines or laughing uncontrollably. <i>He believed that fascism would revive the</i> corpse of <i>Europe</i> .
<u>debris</u>	Scattered pieces of rubbish or remains. Workmen were clearing the roads of the debris from shattered buildings.
<u>dissolution</u>	The process of going into solution. The dissolution of their marriage.
extravagance	The trait of spending extravagantly. We were surprised by the extravagance of his description.
ferment	Cause to undergo fermentation. <i>Her mind ferments.</i>
fermentation	The fermentation process involved in the making of beers wines and spirits in which sugars are converted to ethyl alcohol. <i>I had found Paris in high fermentation</i> .
<u>flesh</u>	Remove the flesh adhering to a skin or hide. She gasped as the cold water hit her flesh .
fungi	The taxonomic kingdom including yeast, molds, smuts, mushrooms, and toadstools; distinct from the green plants.



<u>garbage</u>	Worthless or meaningless material or ideas; rubbish. <i>Garbage</i> littered the estate.
germ	An initial stage from which something may develop. The germ of a brilliant idea.
hamburger	Minced beef.
<u>meat</u>	The flesh of a person's body. Pieces of meat .
multicellular	Consisting of many cells. <i>Multicellular</i> organisms.
mutton	The flesh of fully grown sheep used as food. A leg of mutton .
<u>organism</u>	The material structure of an organism. The Church is a divinely constituted organism .
pork	Gorge oneself with food. <i>Roast pork</i> .
putrescent	Undergoing the process of decay; rotting. A trail lined by putrescent carcasses.
putrid	In an advanced state of decomposition and having a foul odor- Somerset Maugham. <i>The putrid atmosphere of the court.</i>
rot	Liver rot in sheep. The leaves were turning black with rot .
scavenger	A person who searches for and collects discarded items. A reputation as a scavenger of discarded odds and ends.
spoilage	The amount that has spoiled.
steak	A thick slice of steak or other high quality meat or fish. A salmon steak .
uncooked	Not cooked. Frozen ready meals may be completely uncooked .
unicellular	(of an evolutionary or developmental stage) characterized by the formation or presence of a single cell or cells. <i>Patches of unicellular algae.</i>
waste	Run off as waste. Ensure that waste materials are disposed of responsibly.
