## Associations of "Carrion" (30 Words)

<b><u>blubber</u></b>	Cry or whine with snuffling. <i>My six pack is quickly being covered in <b>blubber</b>.</i>
<b>carcass</b>	The dead body of an animal especially one slaughtered and dressed for food. <i>She saw the mud covered <b>carcass</b> of a sheep.</i>
<b>caribou</b>	Arctic deer with large antlers in both sexes called reindeer in Eurasia and caribou in North America.
<b>carnivore</b>	A mammal of the order Carnivora. <i>Terrestrial <b>carnivores</b> have four or five clawed digits on each limb.</i>
<b>corpse</b>	Spoil a piece of acting by forgetting one's lines or laughing uncontrollably. <i>He believed that fascism would revive the <b>corpse</b> of Europe.</i>
<b><u>debris</u></b>	Scattered pieces of rubbish or remains. <i>Workmen were clearing the roads of the <b>debris</b> from shattered buildings.</i>
<b><u>dissolution</u></b>	The process of going into solution. <i>The <b>dissolution</b> of their marriage.</i>
<b>extravagance</b>	The trait of spending extravagantly. <i>We were surprised by the <b>extravagance</b> of his description.</i>
<b>ferment</b>	Cause to undergo fermentation. <i>Her mind <b>ferments</b>.</i>
<b>fermentation</b>	The fermentation process involved in the making of beers wines and spirits in which sugars are converted to ethyl alcohol. <i>I had found Paris in high <b>fermentation</b>.</i>
<b><u>flesh</u></b>	Remove the flesh adhering to a skin or hide. <i>She gasped as the cold water hit her <b>flesh</b>.</i>
<b>fungi</b>	The taxonomic kingdom including yeast, molds, smuts, mushrooms, and toadstools; distinct from the green plants.

<b>garbage</b>	Worthless or meaningless material or ideas; rubbish. <i><b>Garbage</b> littered the estate.</i>
<b>germ</b>	An initial stage from which something may develop. <i>The <b>germ</b> of a brilliant idea.</i>
<b>hamburger</b>	Minced beef.
<b>meat</b>	The flesh of a person's body. <i>Pieces of <b>meat</b>.</i>
<b>multicellular</b>	Consisting of many cells. <i><b>Multicellular</b> organisms.</i>
<b>mutton</b>	The flesh of fully grown sheep used as food. <i>A leg of <b>mutton</b>.</i>
<b>organism</b>	The material structure of an organism. <i>The Church is a divinely constituted <b>organism</b>.</i>
<b>pork</b>	Gorge oneself with food. <i>Roast <b>pork</b>.</i>
<b>putrescent</b>	Undergoing the process of decay; rotting. <i>A trail lined by <b>putrescent</b> carcasses.</i>
<b>putrid</b>	In an advanced state of decomposition and having a foul odor- Somerset Maugham. <i>The <b>putrid</b> atmosphere of the court.</i>
<b>rot</b>	Liver rot in sheep. <i>The leaves were turning black with <b>rot</b>.</i>
<b>scavenger</b>	A person who searches for and collects discarded items. <i>A reputation as a <b>scavenger</b> of discarded odds and ends.</i>
<b>spoilage</b>	The amount that has spoiled.
<b>steak</b>	A thick slice of steak or other high quality meat or fish. <i>A salmon <b>steak</b>.</i>
<b>uncooked</b>	Not cooked. <i>Frozen ready meals may be completely <b>uncooked</b>.</i>
<b>unicellular</b>	(of an evolutionary or developmental stage) characterized by the formation or presence of a single cell or cells. <i>Patches of <b>unicellular</b> algae.</i>
<b>waste</b>	Run off as waste. <i>Ensure that <b>waste</b> materials are disposed of responsibly.</i>
