<u>blubber</u>	Cry or whine with snuffling. My six pack is quickly being covered in <b>blubber</b> .
carcass	The dead body of an animal especially one slaughtered and dressed for food. She saw the mud covered <b>carcass</b> of a sheep.
caribou	Arctic deer with large antlers in both sexes called reindeer in Eurasia and caribou in North America.
carnivore	A mammal of the order Carnivora. Terrestrial <b>carnivore</b> s have four or five clawed digits on each limb.
corpse	Spoil a piece of acting by forgetting one's lines or laughing uncontrollably. <i>He believed that fascism would revive the</i> <b>corpse</b> of <i>Europe</i> .
<u>debris</u>	Scattered pieces of rubbish or remains. Workmen were clearing the roads of the <b>debris</b> from shattered buildings.
<u>dissolution</u>	The process of going into solution. The <b>dissolution</b> of their marriage.
extravagance	The trait of spending extravagantly. We were surprised by the <b>extravagance</b> of his description.
ferment	Cause to undergo fermentation. <i>Her mind <b>ferment</b>s.</i>
fermentation	The fermentation process involved in the making of beers wines and spirits in which sugars are converted to ethyl alcohol. <i>I had found Paris in high fermentation</i> .
<u>flesh</u>	Remove the flesh adhering to a skin or hide. She gasped as the cold water hit her <b>flesh</b> .
fungi	The taxonomic kingdom including yeast, molds, smuts, mushrooms, and toadstools; distinct from the green plants.



<u>garbage</u>	Worthless or meaningless material or ideas; rubbish. <i>Garbage</i> littered the estate.
germ	An initial stage from which something may develop. The <b>germ</b> of a brilliant idea.
hamburger	Minced beef.
<u>meat</u>	The flesh of a person's body. Pieces of <b>meat</b> .
multicellular	Consisting of many cells. <i>Multicellular</i> organisms.
mutton	The flesh of fully grown sheep used as food. A leg of <b>mutton</b> .
<u>organism</u>	The material structure of an organism. The Church is a divinely constituted <b>organism</b> .
pork	Gorge oneself with food. <i>Roast pork</i> .
putrescent	Undergoing the process of decay; rotting. A trail lined by <b>putrescent</b> carcasses.
putrid	In an advanced state of decomposition and having a foul odor- Somerset Maugham. <i>The <b>putrid</b> atmosphere of the court.</i>
rot	Liver rot in sheep. The leaves were turning black with <b>rot</b> .
scavenger	A person who searches for and collects discarded items. A reputation as a <b>scavenger</b> of discarded odds and ends.
spoilage	The amount that has spoiled.
steak	A thick slice of steak or other high quality meat or fish. A salmon <b>steak</b> .
uncooked	Not cooked. Frozen ready meals may be completely <b>uncooked</b> .
unicellular	(of an evolutionary or developmental stage) characterized by the formation or presence of a single cell or cells. <i>Patches of unicellular algae.</i>
waste	Run off as waste. Ensure that <b>waste</b> materials are disposed of responsibly.
