Carve in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I carve We carve
You carve You carve
He/She/It carves They carve

Carve in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural
I am carving We are carving
You are carving You are carving
He/She/It is carving They are carving

Carve in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

I have corven (archaic), carved, or carven

You have corven (archaic), carved, or carven

He/She/It has corven (archaic), carved, or carven

They have corven (archaic), carved, or carven

They have corven (archaic), carved, or carven

Carve in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural
I have been carving We have been carving
You have been carving You have been carving
He/She/It has been carving They have been carving

Carve in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I carved or (archaic) corve We carved or (archaic) corve
You carved or (archaic) corve You carved or (archaic) corve
He/She/It carved or (archaic) corve They carved or (archaic) corve



carven

Carve in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I was carving We were carving
You were carving
He/She/It was carving They were carving

Carve in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had corven (archaic), carved, or carven We had corven (archaic), carved, or

carven

You had corven (archaic), carved, or You had corven (archaic), carved, or

carven

He/She/It had corven (archaic), carved, or They had corven (archaic), carved, or

carven carven

Carve in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been carving
You had been carving
You had been carving
He/She/It had been carving They had been carving

Carve in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will carve
You will carve
He/She/It will carve
They will carve

Carve in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be carving
You will be carving
You will be carving



Singular Plural

He/She/It will be carving They will be carving

Carve in Future Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I will have corven (archaic), carved, or We will have corven (archaic), carved, or

carven carven

You will have corven (archaic), carved, or You will have corven (archaic), carved,

carven or carven

He/She/It will have corven (archaic), They will have corven (archaic), carved,

carved, or carven or carven

Carve in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been carving
You will have been carving
You will have been carving

He/She/It will have been carving They will have been carving
