Catalog in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I catalog We catalog
You catalog You catalog
He/She/It catalogs They catalog

Catalog in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am cataloging We are cataloging
You are cataloging You are cataloging
He/She/It is cataloging They are cataloging

Catalog in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have cataloged We have cataloged You have cataloged You have cataloged He/She/It has cataloged They have cataloged

Catalog in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been cataloging
You have been cataloging
He/She/It has been cataloging
They have been cataloging

Catalog in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I cataloged We cataloged
You cataloged You cataloged
He/She/It cataloged They cataloged

Catalog in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was cataloging We were cataloging
You were cataloging You were cataloging
He/She/It was cataloging They were cataloging

Catalog in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had cataloged We had cataloged
You had cataloged You had cataloged
He/She/It had cataloged They had cataloged

Catalog in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been cataloging We had been cataloging
You had been cataloging You had been cataloging
He/She/It had been cataloging They had been cataloging

Catalog in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will catalog
You will catalog
He/She/It will catalog
They will catalog

Catalog in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be cataloging We will be cataloging
You will be cataloging You will be cataloging
He/She/It will be cataloging They will be cataloging

Catalog in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have cataloged We will have cataloged You will have cataloged He/She/It will have cataloged They will have cataloged

Catalog in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been cataloging
You will have been cataloging
You will have been cataloging
He/She/It will have been cataloging
They will have been cataloging
