Catch in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural
I catch We catch
You catch
He/She/It catches They catch

Catch in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural
I am catching We are catching
You are catching You are catching
He/She/It is catching They are catching

Catch in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have caught We have caught

You have caught You have caught

He/She/It has caught They have caught

Catch in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been catching We have been catching

You have been catching You have been catching

He/She/It has been catching They have been catching

Catch in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

SingularPluralI caughtWe caughtYou caughtYou caughtHe/She/It caughtThey caught

Catch in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was catching
You were catching
He/She/It was catching
They were catching

Catch in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had caught
You had caught
He/She/It had caught
They had caught

Catch in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been catching
You had been catching
You had been catching
He/She/It had been catching
They had been catching

Catch in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will catch We will catch
You will catch You will catch
He/She/It will catch They will catch

Catch in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be catching
You will be catching
He/She/It will be catching
They will be catching

Catch in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have caught
You will have caught
He/She/It will have caught
They will have caught

Catch in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been catching
You will have been catching
He/She/It will have been catching
They will have been catching
