Present Tense	catch / catches
Past Tense	caught
Present Participle	catching
Past Participle	caught

Conjugate Catch

Catch in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **catch** We **catch**
You **catch** You **catch**
He/She/It **catches** They **catch**

Catch in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am catching** We **are catching**
You **are catching** You **are catching**
He/She/It **is catching** They **are catching**

Catch in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have caught** We **have caught**
You **have caught** You **have caught**
He/She/It **has caught** They **have caught**

Catch in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been catching** We **have been catching**
You **have been catching** You **have been catching**
He/She/It **has been catching** They **have been catching**

Catch in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **caught** We **caught**
You **caught** You **caught**
He/She/It **caught** They **caught**

Catch in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was catching We were catching
You were catching You were catching
He/She/It was catching They were catching

Catch in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had caught We had caught
You had caught You had caught
He/She/It had caught They had caught

Catch in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been catching We had been catching
You had been catching You had been catching
He/She/It had been catching They had been catching

Catch in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will catch We will catch
You will catch You will catch
He/She/It will catch They will catch

Catch in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be catching We will be catching
You will be catching You will be catching
He/She/It will be catching They will be catching

Catch in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have caught

We will have caught

You will have caught

You will have caught

He/She/It will have caught

They will have caught

Catch in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been catching

We will have been catching

You will have been catching

You will have been catching

He/She/It will have been catching

They will have been catching
