Synonyms of "Catchphrase" as a noun (11 Words)

catch phrase The quantity that was caught.

A short, eye-catching line of type, such as a running head.

catchline There was an advert for tea that had the **catchline** Tea Best Drink of the

Day.

catchword A word printed or placed so as to attract attention.

Motivation is a great **catchword**.

(Sanskrit) literally a 'sacred utterance' in Vedism; one of a collection of

mantra orally transmitted poetic hymns.

She repeated So pleased with how its going at intervals like a **mantra**.



A favorite saying of a sect or political group.

motto They were developing the use of leitmotifs or **motto**es that appear

throughout an opera.

quotation A short note recognizing a source of information or of a quoted passage.

A great argument with much quotation of Darwin.

A passage or expression that is quoted or cited.

Use double **quote**s around precise phrases you wish to search for.

saying

A word or phrase that particular people use in particular situations.

This is stated in the **saying**s of the Prophet.

slogan A favorite saying of a sect or political group.

Students were chanting **slogan**s.

sound bite An individual sound unit of speech without concern as to whether or not it is

a phoneme of some language.

watchword A word or phrase expressing a person's or group's core aim or belief.

On all educational fronts innovation was the **watchword**.
