<u>procurement</u>	The action of obtaining or procuring something. The company s procurement s from foreign firms.



provide	Make a possibility or provide opportunity for permit to be attainable or cause to remain. We provide d the room with an electrical heater.
provider	Someone whose business is to supply a particular service or commodity. <i>A leading provider of personal financial services.</i>
provision	Supply with provisions. New contracts for the provision of services.
pub	Tavern consisting of a building with a bar and public rooms often provides light meals. <i>Let s go to the pub.</i>
purvey	Supply with provisions. We didn t want to purvey gloom and doom.
purveyor	Someone who supplies provisions (especially food. A purveyor of large luxury vehicles.
render	Give up surrender. The rains render ed his escape impossible.
<u>replenish</u>	Fill something that had previously been emptied. All creatures need sleep to replenish their energies.
<u>restaurant</u>	A place where people pay to sit and eat meals that are cooked and served on the premises.
restock	Stock again. Work began at once to restock the fishery.
service	A company or agency that performs a public service subject to government regulation. <i>He retired after 40 years service</i> .
shop	An act of going shopping. She slogged her way round the supermarket doing the weekly shop .
supplement	A supplementary component that improves capability. <i>Supplement your diet.</i>
<u>supplier</u>	A person or organization that provides something needed such as a product or service. <i>The company has to pay</i> supplier s within 90 days of purchase.
supply	The activity of supplying or providing something. The demand for tickets greatly exceeds the supply .
vouchsafe	Reveal or disclose (information. It is a blessing vouchsafe d him by heaven.
