adduce	Advance evidence for. <i>A number of factors are adduced to explain the situation.</i>
adequately	To a satisfactory or acceptable extent. <i>The job requirements were not adequately explained.</i>
afford	Afford access to. <i>Our meeting afforded much interesting information.</i>
amortization	The action or process of gradually writing off the initial cost of an asset. <i>Because of amortization you ll own your home by the end of the loan term.</i>
bookshop	A shop where books are sold.
contracted	Reduced in size or pulled together. <i>The contracted pupils of her eyes.</i>
customer	Someone who pays for goods or services. <i>Mr Harrison was a regular customer at the Golden Lion.</i>
deliver	Deliver a speech oration or idea. <i>The company has delivered a body blow to this city.</i>
equip	Supply with the necessary items for a particular purpose. <i>The expedition was equipped with proper clothing food and other necessities.</i>
furnish	Supply someone with (something); give (something) to someone. <i>She was able to furnish me with details of the incident.</i>
grocer	A person who sells food and small household goods.
needs	Of necessity. <i>We must needs by objective.</i>
outpace	Go, rise, or improve faster than. <i>Import growth outpaced export growth in the second quarter.</i>
procurement	The action of obtaining or procuring something. <i>The company s procurements from foreign firms.</i>

provide	Make a possibility or provide opportunity for permit to be attainable or cause to remain. <i>We provided the room with an electrical heater.</i>
provider	Someone whose business is to supply a particular service or commodity. <i>A leading provider of personal financial services.</i>
provision	Supply with provisions. <i>New contracts for the provision of services.</i>
pub	Tavern consisting of a building with a bar and public rooms often provides light meals. <i>Let s go to the pub.</i>
purvey	Supply with provisions. <i>We didn t want to purvey gloom and doom.</i>
purveyor	Someone who supplies provisions (especially food). <i>A purveyor of large luxury vehicles.</i>
render	Give up surrender. <i>The rains rendered his escape impossible.</i>
replenish	Fill something that had previously been emptied. <i>All creatures need sleep to replenish their energies.</i>
restaurant	A place where people pay to sit and eat meals that are cooked and served on the premises.
restock	Stock again. <i>Work began at once to restock the fishery.</i>
service	A company or agency that performs a public service subject to government regulation. <i>He retired after 40 years service.</i>
shop	An act of going shopping. <i>She slogged her way round the supermarket doing the weekly shop.</i>
supplement	A supplementary component that improves capability. <i>Supplement your diet.</i>
supplier	A person or organization that provides something needed such as a product or service. <i>The company has to pay suppliers within 90 days of purchase.</i>
supply	The activity of supplying or providing something. <i>The demand for tickets greatly exceeds the supply.</i>
vouchsafe	Reveal or disclose (information). <i>It is a blessing vouchsafed him by heaven.</i>
