Catholicise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I catholicise
You catholicise
He/She/It catholicises They catholicise

Catholicise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am catholicising We are catholicising
You are catholicising You are catholicising
He/She/It is catholicising They are catholicising

Catholicise in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have catholicised We have catholicised You have catholicised He/She/It has catholicised They have catholicised

Catholicise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been catholicising
You have been catholicising
He/She/It has been catholicising
They have been catholicising

Catholicise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I catholicised We catholicised
You catholicised You catholicised
He/She/It catholicised They catholicised

Catholicise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was catholicising We were catholicising
You were catholicising You were catholicising
He/She/It was catholicising They were catholicising

Catholicise in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had catholicised We had catholicised
You had catholicised You had catholicised
He/She/It had catholicised They had catholicised

Catholicise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been catholicising
You had been catholicising
He/She/It had been catholicising
They had been catholicising

Catholicise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will catholicise
You will catholicise
He/She/It will catholicise
They will catholicise

Catholicise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be catholicising
You will be catholicising
He/She/It will be catholicising
They will be catholicising

Catholicise in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have catholicised We will have catholicised You will have catholicised He/She/It will have catholicised They will have catholicised

Catholicise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been catholicising
You will have been catholicising
He/She/It will have been catholicising
They will have been catholicising
