- *The action of causing something.*
- *The relationship between cause and effect; causality.*
- *The act of causing something to happen.*

Synonyms of "Causation" as a noun (12 Words)

causing	The act of causing something to happen.
creation	(theology) God’s act of bringing the universe into existence. <i>She treats fictional creations as if they were real people.</i>
inception	An event that is a beginning; a first part or stage of subsequent events. <i>She has been on the board since its inception two years ago.</i>
initiation	The action of beginning something. <i>An initiation ceremony.</i>
inspiration	Arousal of the mind to special unusual activity or creativity. <i>A rare moment of inspiration in an otherwise dull display.</i>
kindling	Material for starting a fire.

- making** Usually plural the components needed for making or doing something.
*The **making** of videos.*
- origination** The act of starting something for the first time; introducing something new.
*There are a number of theories on the **origination** of the name.*
- production** The process of or management involved in making a film, play, or record.
*Excess **production** of collagen by the liver.*
- prompting** Persuasion formulated as a suggestion.
*The audience could hear his **prompting**.*
- spawning** The mass of eggs deposited by fish or amphibians or molluscs.
- triggering** Lever that activates the firing mechanism of a gun.

Usage Examples of "Causation" as a noun

- *A strong association is not a proof of causation.*
- *The postulated role of nitrate in the causation of cancer.*
