- The altitude of the base of a cloud layer.
- The inside planking of a ship's bottom and sides.
- The maximum altitude that a particular aircraft can reach.
- An upper limit on what is allowed.
- Altitude of the lowest layer of clouds.

An arched brick or stone ceiling or roof.


