## Ceiling as a Noun

### Definitions of "Ceiling" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “ceiling” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *(meteorology) altitude of the lowest layer of clouds.*
- *An upper limit set on prices, wages, or expenditure.*
- *Maximum altitude at which a plane can fly (under specified conditions.*
- *The overhead upper surface of a covered space.*
- *The upper interior surface of a room or other similar compartment.*
- *The altitude of the base of a cloud layer.*
- *The inside planking of a ship's bottom and sides.*
- *The maximum altitude that a particular aircraft can reach.*
- *An upper limit on what is allowed.*
- *Altitude of the lowest layer of clouds.*

<b>cap</b>	A cap awarded as a sign of membership of a particular sports team especially a national team. <i>A former naval officer and rugby <b>cap</b>.</i>
<b>highest permissible level</b>	A public secondary school usually including grades 9 through 12.
<b>highest permissible value</b>	A high place.
<b>limitation</b>	A time period after which suits cannot be brought. <i>It is a good plan but it has serious <b>limitations</b>.</i>
<b><u>maximum</u></b>	A maximum permitted custodial sentence for an offence. <i>An offence which carries a <b>maximum</b> of 14 years.</i>
<b><u>roof</u></b>	Protective covering on top of a motor vehicle. <i>I could see the <b>roof</b> of the bear s mouth.</i>

**upper limit**

Piece of leather or synthetic material that forms the part of a shoe or boot above the sole that encases the foot.

**vault**

A large room or chamber used for storage, especially an underground one.

*A wine **vault**.*

**vaulting**

An arched brick or stone ceiling or roof.

*Arches and **vaulting**.*



**Usage Examples of "Ceiling" as a noun**

- *The aircraft's quoted ceiling of 24,000 feet.*
- *He hated painting the ceiling.*
- *He put a ceiling on the number of women who worked for him.*
- *The government imposed a wage ceiling of 3 per cent.*
- *The books were stacked from floor to ceiling.*



## Associations of "Ceiling" (30 Words)

**anteroom** An antechamber, typically serving as a waiting room.

**apartment** A block of apartments.  
*The family lived in a rented **apartment**.*

**bedroom** A room used primarily for sleeping.  
*A two **bedroom** flat.*

**bottle** Put into bottles.  
***Bottle** the mineral water.*

**bungalow** A low house having only one storey or, in some cases, upper rooms set in the roof, typically with dormer windows.

**cap** A player to whom a cap is awarded.  
*Snow **capped** the mountains.*

**cottage** (in the context of casual homosexual encounters) a public toilet.  
*They said that at some point in their lives they ve **cottaged** or cruised in parks.*

<b>doorstep</b>	A step leading up to the outer door of a house. <i>He put his foot on the <b>doorstep</b> of the cottage.</i>
<b>doorway</b>	An entrance to a room or building through a door. <i>The <b>doorway</b> to success.</i>
<b>dormer</b>	A window that projects vertically from a sloping roof.
<b>floor</b>	Provide a room or area with a floor. <i>That question <b>floored</b> him.</i>
<b>foyer</b>	An entrance hall in a house or flat. <i>The <b>foyer</b> of the concert hall.</i>
<b>furnished</b>	Provided with whatever is necessary for a purpose (as furniture or equipment or authority). <i>A <b>furnished</b> apartment.</i>
<b>hall</b>	The building in which a guild was housed. <i><b>Halls</b> of learning.</i>
<b>house</b>	The management of a gambling house or casino. <i>The <b>house</b> applauded.</i>
<b>hut</b>	Provide with huts. <i>A beach <b>hut</b>.</i>
<b>latticed</b>	Having a pattern of fretwork or latticework. <i>A <b>latticed</b> screen.</i>
<b>lobby</b>	In the UK lobby correspondents collectively. <i>A recent <b>lobby</b> of Parliament by pensioners.</i>
<b>mansion</b>	A terrace or mansion block. <i>Carlyle <b>Mansions</b>.</i>
<b>mews</b>	A row or street of houses or flats that have been converted from stables or built to look like former stables. <i>A <b>mews</b> house.</i>
<b>parlor</b>	A room in a private house or establishment where people can sit and talk and relax.
<b>porch</b>	A veranda. <i>Daniel and Lydia sat out on the <b>porch</b> for many hours.</i>
<b>rafter</b>	Provide a ceiling with rafters. <i>The <b>rafters</b> above his bed.</i>
<b>roof</b>	Provide a building with a roof cover a building with a roof. <i>A car with a vinyl <b>roof</b>.</i>
<b>skylight</b>	A window in a roof to admit daylight.

- tepee** A portable conical tent made of skins, cloth, or canvas on a frame of poles, used by North American Indians of the Plains and Great Lakes regions.
- terrace** Provide a house with a terrace.  
*Breakfast is served on the **terrace**.*
- threshold** A region marking a boundary.  
*On the **threshold** of manhood.*
- treetop** The upper branches and leaves of a tree or other plant.
- vaulted** Having a hemispherical vault or dome.  
*An unusual brick **vaulted** ceiling.*
