Definitions of "Centering" as a noun

- *The concentration of attention or energy on something.*
- *Putting the ball in play by passing it (between the legs) to a back.*
- *(American football) putting the ball in play by passing it (between the legs) to a back.*



Synonyms of "Centering" as a noun (5 Words)

- direction** Something that provides direction or advice as to a decision or course of action.
*He gave **directions** faster than she could follow them.*
- focus** The state or quality of having or producing clear visual definition.
*This generation has made the environment a **focus** of attention.*
- focusing** A point of convergence of light (or other radiation) or a point from which it diverges.
- focussing** The concentration of attention or energy on something.
- snap** Tender green beans without strings that easily snap into sections.
*The infielder's **snap** and throw was a single motion.*
