<b>capital</b>	The upper part of a column that supports the entablature. <i>Murder is the only <b>capital</b> crime in the state.</i>
<b>centered</b>	Being or placed in the center.
<b>central</b>	Serving as an essential component. <i>A <b>central</b> position.</i>

<b>chief</b>	A person who is in charge. <i>The <b>chief</b> aim of living.</i>
<b>civic</b>	Of or relating or belonging to a city. <i>A meeting of <b>civic</b> and business leaders.</i>
<b>concentration</b>	Strengthening the concentration as of a solute in a mixture by removing diluting material. <i><b>Concentration</b> on the needs of the young can mean that the elderly are forgotten.</i>
<b>concentric</b>	Of or denoting circles, arcs, or other shapes which share the same centre, the larger often completely surrounding the smaller. <i>A universe consisting of <b>concentric</b> spheres or layers.</i>
<b>core</b>	Remove the core or center from. <i>Bronzes that have been cast using a clay <b>core</b>.</i>
<b>crucial</b>	Having crucial relevance. <i>A <b>crucial</b> moment in his career.</i>
<b>egoism</b>	Concern for your own interests and welfare.
<b>focal</b>	Relating to the centre or most important part. <i><b>Focal</b> infection.</i>
<b>focus</b>	Place the focus on an element of a sentence. <i>Please <b>focus</b> the image we cannot enjoy the movie.</i>
<b>fulcrum</b>	The point against which a lever is placed to get a purchase, or on which it turns or is supported. <i>Research is the <b>fulcrum</b> of the academic community.</i>
<b>halfway</b>	In the middle of a period of time. <i><b>Halfway</b> measures.</i>
<b>hub</b>	A center of activity or interest or commerce or transportation; a focal point around which events revolve. <i>The airport is the economic <b>hub</b> of the area.</i>
<b>instrumental</b>	A noun in the instrumental case. <i>A largely <b>instrumental</b> piece.</i>
<b>interim</b>	An interim dividend profit etc. <i>An <b>interim</b> agreement.</i>
<b>intermediate</b>	A person at an intermediate level of knowledge or skill. <i><b>Intermediate</b> capacity.</i>
<b>main</b>	Most important element. <i>A <b>main</b> road.</i>

<b>meantime</b>	Meanwhile. <i><b>Meantime</b> he was attentive to his other interests.</i>
<b>mid</b>	Of or in the middle part or position of a range. A <i><b>mid</b></i> central vowel.
<b><u>middle</u></b>	In cricket tennis etc strike the ball with the middle of the bat racket or club. <i>The <b>middle</b> of the war.</i>
<b>middlebrow</b>	A middlebrow person. <i><b>Middlebrow</b> fiction.</i>
<b>midway</b>	Naval battle of World War II (June 1942); American planes based on land and on carriers decisively defeated a Japanese fleet on its way to invade the Midway Islands. <i>The kids head straight for the <b>midway</b>.</i>
<b>neuter</b>	A neuter word. <i>The conquering hero is a <b>neuter</b>.</i>
<b><u>neutral</u></b>	An electrically neutral point terminal conductor or wire. <i><b>Neutral</b> and non aligned European nations.</i>
<b><u>pivot</u></b>	Provide a mechanism with a pivot fix a mechanism on a pivot. <i>He swung round <b>pivoting</b> on his heel.</i>
<b><u>pivotal</u></b>	Being of crucial importance. <i>Its <b>pivotal</b> location has also exposed it to periodic invasions.</i>
<b>point</b>	Extend the toes or feet in line with the leg by tensing the foot and ankle in such a way as to form a point. <i>A row of <b>points</b>.</i>
<b>proximal</b>	Situated nearer to the centre of the body or the point of attachment. <i>The <b>proximal</b> end of the forearm.</i>
