Infinitive	to celebrate
Present Tense	celebrate / celebrates
Past Tense	cerebrated
Present Participle	celebrating
Past Participle	cerebrated

Conjugate Celebrate

Celebrate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **celebrate** We **celebrate**
You **celebrate** You **celebrate**
He/She/It **celebrates** They **celebrate**

Celebrate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am celebrating** We **are celebrating**
You **are celebrating** You **are celebrating**
He/She/It **is celebrating** They **are celebrating**

Celebrate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have celebrated** We **have celebrated**
You **have celebrated** You **have celebrated**
He/She/It **has celebrated** They **have celebrated**

Celebrate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been celebrating** We **have been celebrating**
You **have been celebrating** You **have been celebrating**
He/She/It **has been celebrating** They **have been celebrating**

Celebrate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **celebrated** We **celebrated**
You **celebrated** You **celebrated**
He/She/It **celebrated** They **celebrated**

Celebrate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was celebrating We were celebrating
You were celebrating You were celebrating
He/She/It was celebrating They were celebrating

Cerebrate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had celebrated We had celebrated
You had celebrated You had celebrated
He/She/It had celebrated They had celebrated

Cerebrate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been celebrating We had been celebrating
You had been celebrating You had been celebrating
He/She/It had been celebrating They had been celebrating

Cerebrate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will celebrate We will celebrate
You will celebrate You will celebrate
He/She/It will celebrate They will celebrate

Cerebrate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be celebrating We will be celebrating
You will be celebrating You will be celebrating
He/She/It will be celebrating They will be celebrating

Cerebrate in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have cerebrated

We will have cerebrated

You will have cerebrated

You will have cerebrated

He/She/It will have cerebrated

They will have cerebrated

Cerebrate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been cerebrating

We will have been cerebrating

You will have been cerebrating

You will have been cerebrating

He/She/It will have been cerebrating

They will have been cerebrating
