Present Tense	channel / channels
Past Tense	channelled or channeled
Present Participle	channeling or channelling
Past Participle	channelled or channeled

Conjugate Channel

Channel in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I channel	We channel
You channel	You channel
He/She/It channels	They channel

Channel in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am channeling or channelling	We are channeling or channelling
You are channeling or channelling	You are channeling or channelling
He/She/It is channeling or channelling	They are channeling or channelling

Channel in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have channelled or channeled	We have channelled or channeled
You have channelled or channeled	You have channelled or channeled
He/She/It has channelled or channeled	They have channelled or channeled

Channel in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been channeling or channelling	We have been channeling or channelling
You have been channeling or channelling	You have been channeling or channelling
He/She/It has been channeling or channelling	They have been channeling or channelling

Channel in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I channelled or channeled	We channelled or channeled
You channelled or channeled	You channelled or channeled
He/She/It channelled or channeled	They channelled or channeled



Channel in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I was channeling or channelling	We were channeling or channelling
You were channeling or channelling	You were channeling or channelling
He/She/It was channeling or channelling	J They were channeling or channelling

Channel in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had channelled or channeled	We had channelled or channeled
You had channelled or channeled	You had channelled or channeled
He/She/It had channelled or channeled	l They had channelled or channeled

Channel in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been channeling or channelling	We had been channeling or channelling
You had been channeling or channelling	You had been channeling or channelling
He/She/It had been channeling or channelling	They had been channeling or channelling

Channel in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will channel	We will channel
You will channel	You will channel
He/She/It will channel	They will channel

Channel in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be channeling or channelling	We will be channeling or channelling
You will be channeling or channelling	You will be channeling or channelling
He/She/It will be channeling or channelling	They will be channeling or channelling



Channel in Future Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have channelled or channeled	We will have channelled or channeled
You will have channelled or channeled	You will have channelled or channeled
He/She/It will have channelled or channeled	I They will have channelled or channeled
