# **Conjugate Chap**

## **Chap in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>chap</b>	We chap
You <b>chap</b>	You <b>chap</b>
He/She/It chaps	They chap

## **Chap in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am chapping	We are chapping
You <b>are chapping</b>	You <b>are chapping</b>
He/She/It is chapping	They are chapping

## **Chap in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have chapped	We have chapped
You have chapped	You have chapped
He/She/It has chapped	They have chapped

## **Chap in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been chapping	We have been chapping
You <b>have been chapping</b>	You <b>have been chapping</b>
He/She/It has been chapping	They have been chapping

## **Chap in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I chapped	We <b>chapped</b>
You <b>chapped</b>	You <b>chapped</b>
He/She/It chapped	They <b>chapped</b>

#### **Chap in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was chapping	We were chapping
You <b>were chapping</b>	You were chapping
He/She/It was chapping	They were chapping

## **Chap in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had chapped	We had chapped
You had chapped	You <b>had chapped</b>
He/She/It had chapped They had chapped	

## **Chap in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been chapping	We had been chapping
You <b>had been chapping</b>	You had been chapping
He/She/It had been chapping	They had been chapping

## **Chap in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will chap	We will chap
You <b>will chap</b>	You <b>will chap</b>
He/She/It will chap	They will chap

## **Chap in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be chapping	We will be chapping
You <b>will be chapping</b>	You <b>will be chapping</b>
He/She/It will be chapping	They will be chapping

Singular	Plural
I will have been chapping	We <b>will have been chapping</b>

He/She/It will have been chapping	They will have been chapping
