### Definitions of "Chapel" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “chapel” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A part of a large church or cathedral with its own altar and dedication.*
- *A small building or room used for Christian worship in a school, prison, hospital, or large private house.*
- *The members or branch of a print or newspaper trade union at a particular place of work.*
- *A place of worship that has its own altar.*
- *A chapel of rest.*
- *A place of worship for Nonconformist congregations.*
- *A small building or room used for funeral services.*
- *A service conducted in a place of worship that has its own altar.*



## Synonyms of "Chapel" as a noun (8 Words)

<b>altar</b>	The table in a Christian church at which the bread and wine are consecrated in communion services.
<b>chapel service</b>	A means of serving.
<b><u>church</u></b>	The body of people who attend or belong to a particular local church. <i>The separation of <b>church</b> and state.</i>
<b>holy place</b>	A sacred place of pilgrimage.
<b><u>sanctuary</u></b>	A place where injured or unwanted animals of a specified kind are cared for. <i>His sons took <b>sanctuary</b> in the church.</i>
<b>sanctum</b>	A sacred place of pilgrimage. <i>He withdrew to his <b>sanctum</b> sanctorum where the children could never go.</i>



**tabernacle**      The Mormon temple.

**temple**            A thing regarded as holy or likened to a temple especially a person's body.  
*The veins in his **temple** throbbed.*



## Usage Examples of "Chapel" as a noun

- *Mr Brind was the head of the BBC's NUJ chapel.*
- *The funeral was in the chapel at Broadfoot Brothers Funeral Home.*
- *He was late for chapel.*
- *A service in the chapel.*
- *She went to chapel twice on Sunday.*
- *The first chapel on the right of the cathedral is dedicated to St Ludmila.*
