Definitions of "Chapel" as a noun

- *A part of a large church or cathedral with its own altar and dedication.*
- *A small building or room used for Christian worship in a school, prison, hospital, or large private house.*
- *The members or branch of a print or newspaper trade union at a particular place of work.*
- *A place of worship that has its own altar.*
- *A chapel of rest.*
- *A place of worship for Nonconformist congregations.*
- *A small building or room used for funeral services.*
- *A service conducted in a place of worship that has its own altar.*



Synonyms of "Chapel" as a noun (8 Words)

- altar** The table in a Christian church at which the bread and wine are consecrated in communion services.
- chapel service** A means of serving.
- [church](#)** The body of people who attend or belong to a particular local church.
*The separation of **church** and state.*
- holy place** A sacred place of pilgrimage.
- [sanctuary](#)** A place where injured or unwanted animals of a specified kind are cared for.
*His sons took **sanctuary** in the church.*
- sanctum** A sacred place of pilgrimage.
*He withdrew to his **sanctum** sanctorum where the children could never go.*

tabernacle The Mormon temple.

temple A thing regarded as holy or likened to a temple especially a person's body.
*The veins in his **temple** throbbed.*

- *He was late for chapel.*
- *A service in the chapel.*
