Character in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I character We character
You character You character
He/She/It characters They character

Character in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am charactering We are charactering
You are charactering You are charactering
He/She/It is charactering They are charactering

Character in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have charactered We have charactered You have charactered You have charactered He/She/It has charactered They have charactered

Character in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been charactering
You have been charactering
You have been charactering
He/She/It has been charactering
They have been charactering

Character in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **charactered** We **charactered**You **charactered** You **charactered**He/She/It **charactered** They **charactered**

Character in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was charactering We were charactering
You were charactering You were charactering
He/She/It was charactering They were charactering

Character in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had charactered We had charactered You had charactered He/She/It had charactered They had charactered

Character in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been charactering
You had been charactering
He/She/It had been charactering
They had been charactering

Character in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will character
You will character
He/She/It will character They will character

Character in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be charactering
You will be charactering
He/She/It will be charactering
They will be charactering
They will be charactering

Character in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have charactered We will have charactered You will have charactered He/She/It will have charactered They will have charactered

Character in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been charactering
You will have been charactering
He/She/It will have been charactering
They will have been charactering
