Infinitive	<b>to characterise</b>
Present Tense	<b>characterise / characterises</b>
Past Tense	<b>characterised</b>
Present Participle	<b>characterising</b>
Past Participle	<b>characterised</b>

## Conjugate Characterise

**Characterise in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>characterise</b>	We <b>characterise</b>
You <b>characterise</b>	You <b>characterise</b>
He/She/It <b>characterises</b>	They <b>characterise</b>

### **Characterise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am characterising</b>	We <b>are characterising</b>
You <b>are characterising</b>	You <b>are characterising</b>
He/She/It <b>is characterising</b>	They <b>are characterising</b>

### **Characterise in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have characterised</b>	We <b>have characterised</b>
You <b>have characterised</b>	You <b>have characterised</b>
He/She/It <b>has characterised</b>	They <b>have characterised</b>

### **Characterise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been characterising</b>	We <b>have been characterising</b>
You <b>have been characterising</b>	You <b>have been characterising</b>
He/She/It <b>has been characterising</b>	They <b>have been characterising</b>

### **Characterise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>characterised</b>	We <b>characterised</b>
You <b>characterised</b>	You <b>characterised</b>
He/She/It <b>characterised</b>	They <b>characterised</b>

### **Characterise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was characterising**                      We **were characterising**  
You **were characterising**              You **were characterising**  
He/She/It **was characterising**      They **were characterising**

**Characterise in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had characterised**                      We **had characterised**  
You **had characterised**              You **had characterised**  
He/She/It **had characterised**      They **had characterised**

**Characterise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been characterising**              We **had been characterising**  
You **had been characterising**              You **had been characterising**  
He/She/It **had been characterising**      They **had been characterising**

**Characterise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will characterise**                      We **will characterise**  
You **will characterise**              You **will characterise**  
He/She/It **will characterise**      They **will characterise**

**Characterise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be characterising**              We **will be characterising**  
You **will be characterising**              You **will be characterising**  
He/She/It **will be characterising**      They **will be characterising**

**Characterise in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have characterised**

**We will have characterised**

**You will have characterised**

**You will have characterised**

**He/She/It will have characterised**

**They will have characterised**

**Characterise in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been characterising**

**We will have been characterising**

**You will have been characterising**

**You will have been characterising**

**He/She/It will have been characterising**

**They will have been characterising**
