<b>cultured</b>	Marked by refinement in taste and manners. <b>Cultured</b> tastes.
<b>cute</b>	Attractive in a pretty or endearing way. She had a <b>cute</b> little nose.
<b>debonair</b>	Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air. Life that is gay brisk and <b>debonair</b> .
<b><u>delightful</u></b>	Greatly pleasing or entertaining. A <b>delightful</b> secluded garden.
<b>elegant</b>	Suggesting taste, ease, and wealth. Small churches with <b>elegant</b> white spires.
<b><u>endearing</u></b>	Inspiring affection. An <b>endearing</b> little grin.
<b>good-looking</b>	Pleasing in appearance especially by reason of conformity to ideals of form and proportion- Thackeray.
<b>likeable</b>	(of characters in literature or drama) evoking empathic or sympathetic feelings. A very <b>likeable</b> young woman.
<b>lovable</b>	Inspiring or deserving love or affection. He has a <b>lovable</b> sweet personality.
<b>lovely</b>	Very beautiful or attractive. How <b>lovely</b> to see you.
<b>magic</b>	Wonderful; exciting. A <b>magic</b> wand.
<b><u>magical</u></b>	Possessing or using or characteristic of or appropriate to supernatural powers. <b>Magical</b> healing powers.
<b><u>pleasant</u></b>	(of persons) having pleasing manners or behavior. They found him <b>pleasant</b> and cooperative.
<b>pleasing</b>	Pleasant or agreeable to the senses. A <b>pleasing</b> piece of news.
<b>prepossessing</b>	Creating a favorable impression. He was not a <b>prepossessing</b> sight.
<b><u>sophisticated</u></b>	Appealing to or frequented by people who are sophisticated. A <b>sophisticated</b> book.

<b>sorcerous</b>	Possessing or using or characteristic of or appropriate to supernatural powers.
<b><u>suave</u></b>	Charming, confident, and elegant (typically used of a man). <i>All the waiters were <b>suave</b> and deferential.</i>
<b><u>sweet</u></b>	Having a sweet nature befitting an angel or cherub. <i>My <b>sweet</b> love.</i>
<b>well bred</b>	In good health especially after having suffered illness or injury.
<b>witching</b>	Possessing or using or characteristic of or appropriate to supernatural powers- Shakespeare. <i>Tis now the very <b>witching</b> time of night.</i>
<b><u>wizard</u></b>	Wonderful; excellent. <i>I ve just had a <b>wizard</b> idea.</i>
<b>wizardly</b>	Possessing or using or characteristic of or appropriate to supernatural powers. <b>Wizardly</b> powers.
<b><u>worldly</u></b>	(of a person) experienced and sophisticated. <b>Worldly</b> goods and advancement.
<b>worldly-wise</b>	Experienced in and wise to the ways of the world.

<b>aesthetically</b>	In a tasteful way. <i>His naive use of rhyme makes his poetry sound <b>aesthetically</b> amateurish.</i>
<b>allure</b>	Powerfully attract or charm; tempt. <i>People for whom gold holds no <b>allure</b>.</i>
<b>alluring</b>	Powerfully and mysteriously attractive or fascinating; seductive. <i>Her <b>alluring</b> smile.</i>
<b>appealing</b>	Evoking empathic or sympathetic feelings. <i>Village life is somehow more <b>appealing</b>.</i>
<b>attract</b>	Be attractive to. <i>He hoped this strategy would <b>attract</b> foreign investment by multinationals.</i>

<b>chic</b>	Elegant and stylish. <i>The hotel s lobby and restaurant are the height of designer <b>chic</b>.</i>
<b>coquettish</b>	Like a coquette. <i>A <b>coquettish</b> grin.</i>

<b><u>fascination</u></b>	The state of being intensely interested (as by awe or terror). <i>He had a lifelong <b>fascination</b> with science.</i>
<b>glamorize</b>	Make glamorous and attractive. <i>The lyrics <b>glamorize</b> drugs.</i>
<b>glamorous</b>	Having an air of allure, romance and excitement. <i>I really wanted the <b>glamorous</b> job of a flight attendant.</i>

<b><u>personable</u></b>	Pleasant in appearance and personality. <i>He was so <b>personable</b> and well spoken.</i>
<b><u>ravishing</u></b>	Stunningly beautiful. <i>She looked <b>ravishing</b>.</i>
<b><u>seductive</u></b>	Tempting and attractive; enticing. <i>A <b>seductive</b> voice.</i>
<b><u>tempting</u></b>	Highly attractive and able to arouse hope or desire. <i>A <b>tempting</b> financial offer.</i>
